## Chateau de Lescours St Emilion Grand Cru



### 2016 Vintage

*80% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc*

The vines are planted on a sandy, gravel soil with an average of 45 years old and some as old as 100 years. Traditional fermentation takes place over a 25-30 day period. The wine is then aged 12 months in oak barrels.

### 93 Points Wine Enthusiast

*This is a ripe, perfumed wine. Aged in wood, it is full bodied, rich, complex and packed with black-plum flavors. The tannins are almost soft enough and this wine should be ready from 2021.*
