### ELIGIBILITY

#### Requirement A



*Pass*

the most recent CA ELA Assessment with *Standard Met or Above*

#### Requirement B



*Complete*

four years of English with an overall GPA of 2.0 or above (*exclude Spring 2020*)

\*\*\* (*Must have received a passing grade or credit in Spring 2020 due to COVID*)

#### Requirement C



*Demonstrate*

proficiency in a language other than English through ONE of the following methods:

- Pass a World Language Advanced Placement exam with a minimum score of a 3
- Pass the International Baccalaureate examination with a minimum score of a 4
- Pass the SAT II World Language Exam with a score of 600 or higher
- Successfully complete a four-year course of study (equivalent to taking level 4 or higher) in world language with a minimum GPA average of 3.0 (*exclude Spring 2020*)

\*\*\* (*Must have received a passing grade or credit in Spring 2020 due to COVID*)

#### Requirement D



*Pass*

Tustin Unified School District's oral examination conducted by a world language teacher with a minimum score of 2 (*If you passed an AP/IB/SAT II test as a 9th/10th/11th grader, you are exempt from this requirement*)

#### **If you currently take the ELPAC**

#### Requirement E



*Demonstrate*

proficiency on the English Language Proficiency Assessments for California (ELPAC)

\*Latin students or qualifying students of languages not taught at TUSD will complete an alternate assessment.
