



## **UNITED AIRLINES MAINTENANCE CONTROLLERS NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE – 06/13/2019**

Members,

Your IBT Negotiation Committee has concluded another round of bargaining June 9 through June 12, 2019. The Union used the first day to compose a response to the Company's latest economic pass. Our response took into consideration several recent developments within the industry. Early the second day, the Union passed the revised economic package across the negotiations table and explained the modifications within the proposal. The parties separated for the remainder of the morning as the Company evaluated our economic pass. An economic counterproposal from the Company has not been received as of this writing.

The remainder of Tuesday morning was spent in a private session with the Mediator reviewing the Union's stance on multiple open items. Tuesday afternoon the parties returned to the table for a Mediator lead a joint session aimed at closing some of the loopholes within the original Hours of Service Article.

The same format continued into Wednesday and lead to solid progress towards clearing a major hurdle within the Hours of Service Article. We anticipate draft language from that session to be exchanged prior to the July sessions.
