Please drop in for coffee, read a newspaper, go through our referral binders, visit, use the telephone. All programs and services are free at Red Road, and transportation is provided for those attending programs. Counseling, specific referrals, resumes, home visitation is also available through appointments on a 'first come first serve' basis. Red Road programs of culture, self-esteem, literacy, tutoring, 'Baby Bonding', LONGHOUSE, Tobacco and Drug prevention are on-going throughout the year in the society's meeting rooms. Our 10-12 week formal parenting and cultural programs run from September to December in the fall, and January to June in the winter. If the temperature is -20 C or colder, we *generally* are not open. Please call ahead. In the summer, if an outdoor activity has been planned; such as horseback riding or picking herbs; and it is raining; we usually cancel. So it is always best to call ahead.
