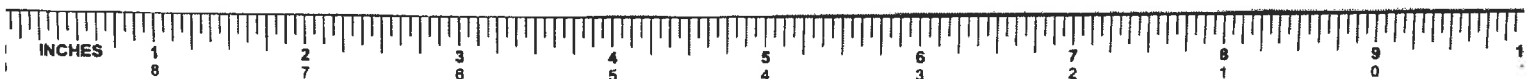
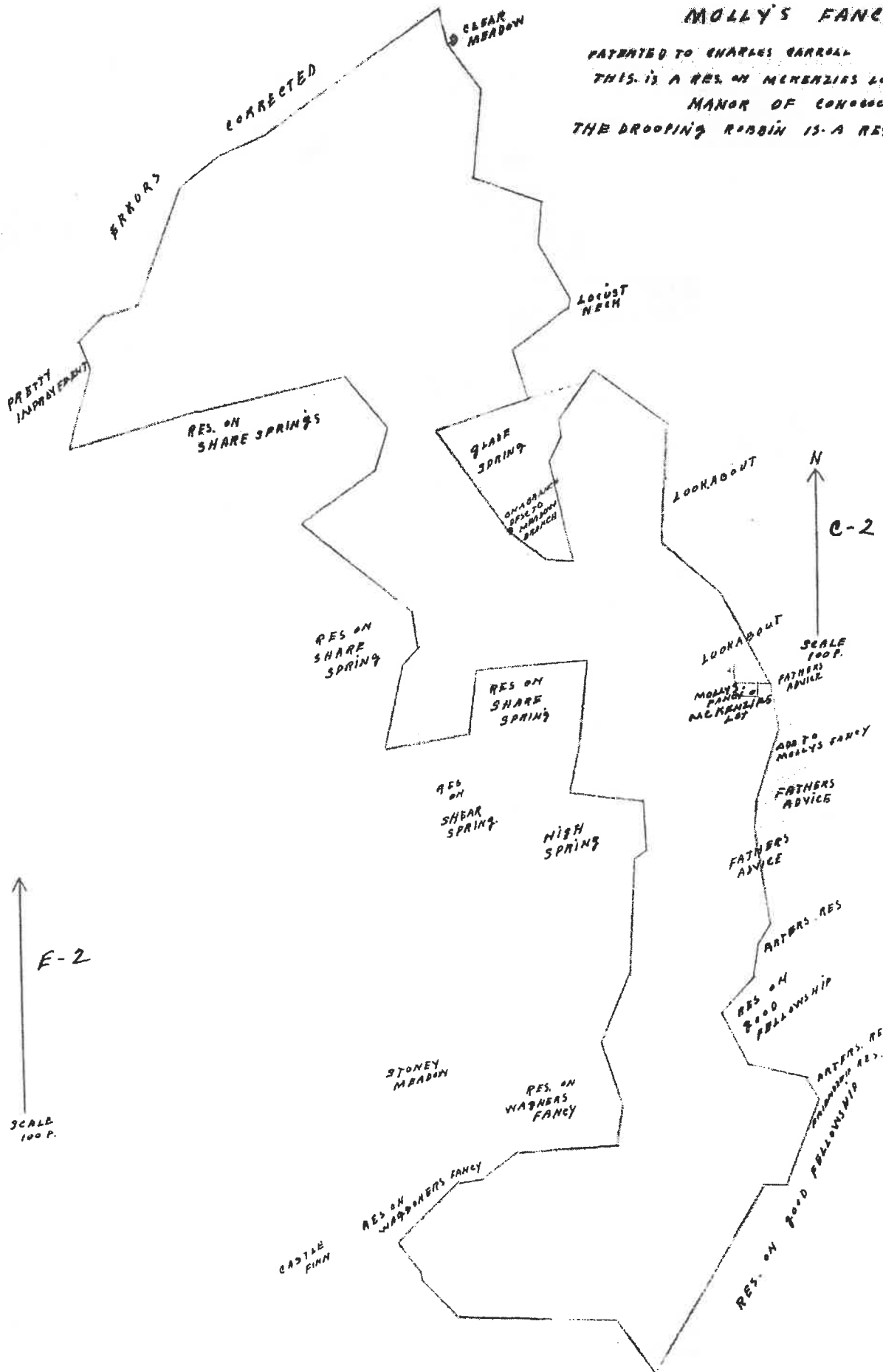

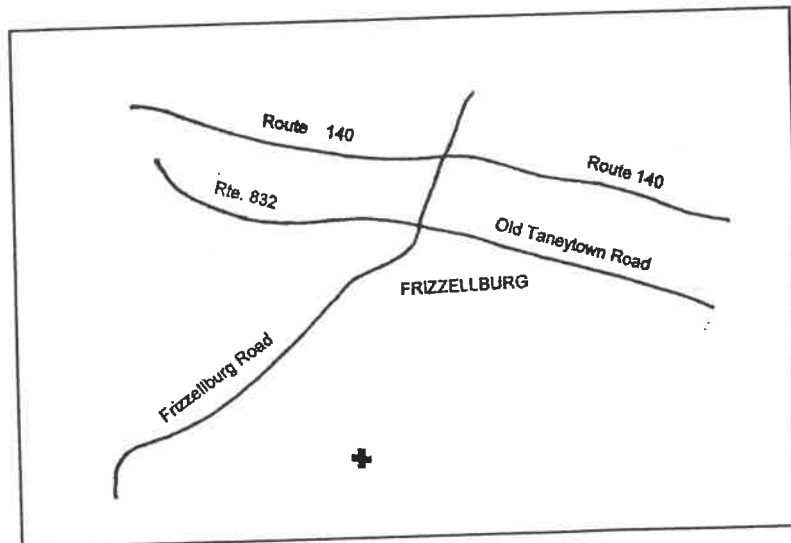


Andrew Myers Family Cemetery

[Cemetery 2-20]

Several people reported this cemetery's existence and copied the tombstones. The Society is indebted to Robert Barnes and to Newton and Virginia Poling for their information. Barnes described the cemetery as located on the Thomas Farm about 200 yards east of the farmhouse. The farmhouse is at the end of a lane which leads east off the Frizzellburg Road about three-quarters of a mile south of Frizzellburg. Both the

Polings and Barnes found the cemetery in poor shape when they visited. The Polings saw the cemetery in the 1987 and Barnes saw it at a later date when the Thomas Farm was for sale. In 1999, the property belonged to Mr. and Mrs. R. Wayne Barnes. It is possible that additional tombstones are hidden in the underbrush. One footstone marked "S.M." does not correspond to any name appearing on the headstones. The Myers farm was purchased about 1792 and remained in the family until 1961. Various deeds refer to the existence of the cemetery. In the 1980s, the farmhouse was approximately 170 years old.
