#### **Tournament Format:**

This series event will be a fantastic opportunity for all karate-ka to test their skills in a non-threatening environment fostering growth and development.

WKF Kata Rules – Guaranteed 2-4 katas performed per competitor. 3-5 athletes in each division and will compete Red vs Blue simultaneously, round robin format.

WKF Kumite Rules – spread of 8 points – absolutely no face contact and minimal body contact. Penalty points as per KBC modifications will be enforced.

Each division will be separated into groups of 3-5. There will be medals for ALL competitors. Each group will compete in a round robin (3 fights minimum per competitor) to determine the medal standings.

#### **Each division will cap at 24 athletes only.**

Dojo instructors are highly encouraged to come coach, officiate, and be a part of the event. This is an informative skill building tournament series for athletes, coaches, and parents.

Team Kata will be scorecards. Not all athletes will get medals, only top 4.
