Abdomen, Pelvis WITHOUT IV Contrast and WITH Barium	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nothing to eat or drink 6 hours prior to exam.</li> <li>• Drink entire bottle of Barium 1-1.5 hours prior to exam.</li> </ul>
Abdomen, Pelvis WITH IV Contrast and Barium**	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Nothing to eat or drink 6 hours prior to exam.</li> <li>• Drink entire bottle of Barium 1-1.5 hours prior to exam.</li> </ul>

\*\***MUST** have lab work, including Creatinine, BUN, and GFR, within 30 days of exam or exam will be rescheduled.
