



APP PROFILE: KID IN STORY BOOK MAKER (by Enuma, Inc.; \$8.99)

Does your child have a hard time transitioning to novel activities or environments, or simply participating in routine activities? Perhaps he or she is anxious about the unknown of what lies ahead? Or, perhaps he or she truly doesn't understand what to do. Providing multi-modal input (e.g., spoken language and visual supports) can be incredibly helpful to help establish task expectations, promote appropriate behavior and encourage self-monitoring. While Social Stories™ and book previews sound like great options, they can often be challenging to make. That's where Kid in Story Book can be great! This app works on iPhones and iPads and it lets you quickly and easily:

- Create a digital story book with customized pictures, text and audio
- Lasso out a person and resize and rotate them within an environment (e.g., if your child is preparing to go to a new school, you can take a picture of your child and a picture of the new school – then, place your child in the foreground of the school image; see example)
- Export stories to PDF so you can print them out and read them later!
- Share stories between devices using email and Dropbox
