

## Ink Blots

Number of players – 2 or more

**Materials:** Copy paper                      Ink or paint                      Lined paper                      Pencil  
Timer

### Directions:

#### Making the ink blots

1. Fold a piece of copy paper in half.
2. Splatter a few drops of ink or paint around one half of the copy paper.
3. Fold the copy paper together and lightly press down.
4. Open the paper to view the ink blot picture.

#### Playing ink blots:

1. Each player is given a sheet of lined paper and a pencil.
2. You will have 5 minutes to write down as many objects as you can see within the ink blot. Be creative, but be prepared to defend your list.
3. After 5 minutes, each person says what is written on their list. If you have the same item, that item is canceled out on all lists and no one receives a point.
4. If you state an object that no one has, but at least one other player sees it, you can keep that object and get one point for having a unique object. If no one can see it, try to defend it until one other person says they see it or cross it off the list and get no point.
5. Winner is the one with the most unique points.
6. Can be played with partners.
