THE SINGULAR SANTIAGO HOTEL OPENS

A recent addition to Chile's capital city, the Singular Santiago is the long-awaited follow-up to its celebrated sister property in Patagonia, which opened in late 2011. The intimate urban hotel recently took up residence near the Forestal Park in the city's cultural and creative district of Lastarria. Architect Federico Prieto of G6 Architects and interior designer Enrique Concha, both of whom are based in Chile, were influenced by neoclassical French architecture and buildings from the early 20th century. At the restaurant, chef Laurent Pasqualetto serves up local flavors using classic French techniques. And if relaxation is what you're after, you won't regret a trip to the spa or the rooftop pool. *From \$320/night; thesingular.com*
