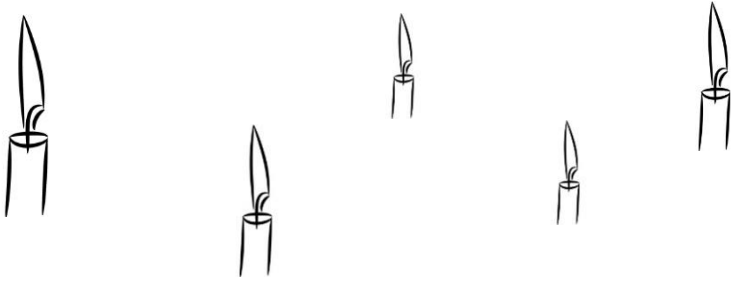

Sing the refrain twice to begin, once between each petition, and twice at the conclusion of our prayers.




Lord, lis-ten to your chil-dren pray-ing, Lord, send your Spir-it in this place;
