100% Chardonnay MARLBOROUGH				
This Methode Traditionnelle exhibits lively bead with persistent mousse. Fresh summer peaches. Roasted hazelnuts and pastry crust on the nose are followed by a rich broad palate with subtle sweetness balancing the zingy acidity. This classic sparkling finishes with great purity and length.

The 2019 Sauvignon Blanc has aromas of nectarine, citrus peel and passion fruit on the nose, with hints of fig leaf & nettle. In the mouth crisp, fresh acidity frames the sweet fruit through the palate.

100% Pinot Noir CENTRAL OTAGO				
A late spring in Central Otago, followed by a cooler than average summer, has given this Rosé excellent fruit freshness and vibrancy. The 2019 Rosé is pale salmon pink in the glass with excellent clarity. On the nose there are elegant aromas of red fruits, raspberry, watermelon and floral notes. The palate is of a very balanced wine, long persistence with a burst of red fruits and watermelon.

HAWKE'S BAY				
The 2016 fallen angel chardonnay is 100% barrel fermented & aged in French oak, with 25% being new. On the nose, ripe peach and nectarine combine beautifully with the creamy, buttery complexity from the malolactic fermentation and the subtle toasty oak. In the mouth, this Chardonnay has a wonderful creamy texture and is med-full bodied with great balance & length.

On the nose scents of fresh pear and almond mingle with subtle floral notes. The palate is full and luscious, with soft acidity and generous mouth feel.

Lifted aromas of orange blossom, fresh lime zest and honeycomb characterize the intriguing nose on this classic Marlborough Riesling. The palate is very concentrated, with a beautiful minerality to the acidity providing a perfect complement to the sweet core fruit and the finish is long and persistent.

### **STONYRIDGE FAITHFUL BORDEAUX**

CABERNET SAUVIGNON, MERLOT, PETIT VERDOT  
WAIHEKE ISLAND

Grown on sun baked north facing slopes, this left bank Bordeaux blend shows classic characteristics of wild berries, black cherries and plums. Secondary aromas of toasty, but subtle, French oak and spices lead into a palate of ripe soft tannin and a smooth finish. Produced as an early drinking, fruit forward style of wine.

### **STONYRIDGE PILGRIM 2018**

SYRAH, MOURVÉDRE, GRENACHE, VIOGNIER  
WAIHEKE ISLAND

For centuries, pilgrims have passed through southern France on their way to Spain and the church of Santiago de Compostela. Their symbol is the scallop shell, which appears on frescoes throughout the region, indicating pilgrims are welcome and safe. This pilgrimage involved dedication, devotion and discipline, just like winemaking, and is the inspiration behind the name of this wine.

Pilgrim 2018 is classically varietal, with complex spice and wild berries on the nose, while the palate shows ripe tannin structure, sweet fruit and a long finish.

### **STONYRIDGE LUNA NEGRA 2018**

We are devoted to creating the finest quality Malbec in the world, grown on our vineyard, Viña del Mar. This extremely low cropping, steep, north facing site combined with meticulous viticulture and traditional winemaking techniques create an inky dark “Luna Negra”, our very own “Black Moon”.

One the nose, concentrated aromas of ripe blueberry and florals with dark chocolate are backed up by cinnamon and cedar from the 50% new French oak. The palate is rich and intense, firm tannin supports the sweet fruit core magnificently. Drinking Luna Negra is like doing an energetic dance with a Cuban beauty queen.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> vintage of Larose, 1987, won the trophy for best Bordeaux style blend in New Zealand and was hailed as the greatest red wine ever to be made in New Zealand, vindicating Stephen’s foresight and commitment to making the finest wine in the nation. We use hands-on, labour intensive viticulture techniques to chase perfection in each and every vintage. We have the most experienced production team on Waiheke that pursue this goal with passion each and every harvest. 31 vintages and counting, Larose is now considered to be the most collectable wine in New Zealand, a reputation that is the envy of the country’s industry.
