

# *Welcome to Stonyridge Vineyard*

## *Our Story*

*Stonyridge Vineyard is the ongoing dream of owner Stephen White. In 1981 Stephen returned to New Zealand after successfully sailing the Whitbread Round the World Yacht Race. Then he set off to explore, skipping yachts in the Mediterranean and Caribbean and working in wineries throughout France, Italy, and California. It was during this 3-year adventure that Stephen came to love the culture and lifestyle of the Mediterranean and the great red wines of France, Tuscany, and California.*

*After extensive climatic research on Waiheke Island, Stonyridge was discovered as the ideal site to ripen and produce a world class Bordeaux style red wine.*

*The first Bordeaux vines and olive trees were planted by Stephen in 1982, with the help of close friends and family. This makes Stonyridge the first commercial olive grove in New Zealand. When Cabernet Franc and Malbec were planted in 1983, it was the beginning of New Zealand's first Bordeaux four blend.*

*In 1984 Stephen returned to Bordeaux for a final training period and to collect the Petit Verdot variety. It was in this period that he completed a vintage at Chateau d'Angludet, Cantenac-Margaux, under the esteemed tutelage of Peter Sichel.*

*Stephen produced the first vintage at Stonyridge Vineyard in 1985. Two years later, he made the great 1987 Larose that rocketed Stonyridge to national fame and attracted international attention – a wine hailed as the greatest red wine ever made in New Zealand.*

*Today Stonyridge is referred to as “One of the Top Ten Must Visit Wineries in the World” Guardian UK and most recently topped the list for the best Cabernet Merlot in the Age/ Sydney Morning Herald Good Wine Guide 2013. The Stonyridge Larose 2010 scored 97 points to make it the highest equal scoring red wine in 2013 and finished ahead of all of Australia’s most iconic Cabernet Merlots!*

*Stonyridge Larose features on the wine lists of some of the best restaurants in the world, from the renowned Restaurante Viridiana in Madrid to London’s iconic Dorchester Hotel. Indeed, Larose is the favourite of the former NZ Prime Minister, Sir John Key, and has been royally enjoyed by the reigning Queen Elizabeth II of England.*

### **STONYRIDGE RESERVE VIOGNIER 2020**

WAIHEKE ISLAND

*Grown in the coastal hills of Waiheke island, this Viognier shows classically varietal characters of apricot and honeysuckle with secondary aromas of Acacia from barrel fermentation. The palate is succulent and generous with well-integrated phenolics and soft acidity.*

### **STONYRIDGE RESERVE PINOT GRIS 2020**

WAIHEKE ISLAND

*Grown on the western end of Waiheke Island, this is a warm climate expression of Pinot Gris; honeycomb, stone fruit and pear, with notes of roasted almonds, thanks to barrel ferment and lees aging. The palate is rich and unctuous with soft acidity.*

*The new wine in the Stonyridge Estate portfolio. This Chardonnay is made from the same clones that go into the famed wines of Corton-Charlemagne, and as such the 2019 Luna Dorada shows richness and enormity, but with many layers of complexity. The oak ageing is 80% of the highest quality new French oak available and is perfectly integrated. Luna Dorada is an unapologetic, ripe style of Chardonnay, designed to make fans of properly made Chardonnays rekindle their love for the Queen of white grape varieties. <p><b>STONYRIDGE SYRAH</b> Waiheke Island- 2018 <i>This Syrah is grown on the eastern hills of Waiheke Island, where cooler temperatures and higher altitudes promote freshness and brightness. With subtle French oak character, this Syrah has fine, soft tannins, generous fruit through the mid-palate with pleasing length and balance.</i></p>	\$5	\$15	\$60	\$55
<p><b>STONYRIDGE FAITHFUL</b> Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot Waiheke Island- 2019 <i>Grown on sun baked north facing slopes, this left bank Bordeaux blend shows classic characteristics of wild berries, black cherries and plums. Secondary aromas of toasty, but subtle, French oak and spices lead into a palate of ripe soft tannins and a smooth finish. <p><b>STONYRIDGE AIRFIELD</b> Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec, Merlot, Cabernet Franc Waiheke Island - 2019 <i>Larose's baby brother has always been an excellent wine in its own right. Forward ripe currant and boysenberry sit alongside thyme and lavender on the nose. The palate structure is soft and supple, and beautiful drinking while young and vibrant.</i></p>	\$6	\$18	\$80	\$70
<p><b>STONYRIDGE PILGRIM</b> Syrah, Mourvèdre, Grenache, Viognier Waiheke Island- 2019 <i>2019 was a great vintage for Syrah on Waiheke, and this estate grown Northern Rhone blend is a perfect exemplar of the vintage. Black plum and blueberry are followed by very pretty florals and baking spice on the nose. The palate is harmonious, with fine structure and soft acidity. Black and blue forest fruit on the nose with a hint of wild herb and a generous lick of oak. The palate is rich, long, and dangerously drinkable. The 2019 is capable of cellaring for many years. *Gentle north facing slopes sheltered from the cool southerly winds by the ridge which gives Stonyridge its name, provide perfect climatic conditions for ripening red Bordeaux grape varieties. The third vintage of Larose 1987 won the trophy for best Bordeaux style blend in New Zealand and was hailed as the greatest red wine ever to be made in New Zealand; vindicating Stephen's foresight and commitment to making the finest wine in the nation. Thirty-four vintages and counting, Larose is now considered to be the most collectable wine in New Zealand, a reputation that is the envy of the country's winemaking industry. An amazing wine of deep colour, flavours saturated with ripe plums, berry fruits and vanilla with layers of soft textured tannins.*

<b>FALLEN ANGEL ROSÉ</b> Marlborough - 2020 <i>Made with Pinot Noir, the nose of this 2019 rosé offers elegant aromas of raspberry, pineapple and floral notes. On the palate it is a very balanced wine, it has a long persistence with a burst of red fruits and tropical notes. <b>FALLEN ANGEL CHARDONNAY</b> Hawkes Bay - 2018 <i>This 2018 Chardonnay is 100% barrel fermented and aged in French oak, with 25% being new. On the nose, ripe peach and nectarine combine beautifully with the creamy, buttery complexity from the malolactic fermentation and the subtle toasty oak. In the mouth, this Chardonnay has a wonderful creamy texture and is medium full bodied with great balance &amp; length.</i>	\$4	\$13	\$50	\$45

<b>FALLEN ANGEL RIESLING</b> Marlborough - 2019 <i>Lifted aromas of orange blossom, fresh lime zest and honeycomb characterise the intriguing nose on this classic Marlborough Riesling.
