<p>The 2019 Sauvignon Blanc exhibits aromas of ripe tropical fruits, melon and a gentle herbaceousness on the nose, while the palate shows great focus and texture from the partial barrel ferment. Perfect for immediate drinking, but will also cellar for up to three years.</p>				
STONYRIDGE RESERVE VIOGNIER 2020

<p>Grown in the coastal hills of Waiheke island, this Viognier shows classically varietal characters of apricot and honeysuckle with secondary aromas of Acacia from barrel fermentation. The palate is succulent and generous with well-integrated phenolics and soft acidity.</p>				
STONYRIDGE RESERVE PINOT GRIS 2020

<p>Grown on the western end of Waiheke Island, this is a warm climate expression of Pinot Gris; honeycomb, stone fruit and pear, with notes of roasted almonds, thanks to barrel ferment and lees aging. The palate is rich and unctuous with soft acidity.</p>

This Syrah is grown on the eastern hills of Waiheke Island, where cooler temperatures and higher altitudes promote freshness and brightness. With subtle French oak character, this Syrah has fine, soft tannins, generous fruit through the mid-palate with pleasing length and balance.

WAIHEKE ISLAND

For centuries, pilgrims have passed through southern France on their way to Spain and the church of Santiago de Compostela. This pilgrimage involved dedication, devotion and discipline, just like winemaking, and is the inspiration behind the name of this wine. Pilgrim 2019 is classically varietal, with complex spice and wild berries on the nose, while the palate shows ripe tannin structure, sweet fruit and a long finish.
