Does your company want to bid on work for San Diego Unified School District? You are now **REQUIRED** to be prequalified on a yearly basis with the District in order to perform work for the District.

What does this mean?

If you let your prequalification lapse, or you are not prequalified, you will not be able to perform work for San Diego Unified School District even if you are selected as a bidder by Soltek. So, if you want to be in good standing and be eligible to participate in a big pool of work coming out for the District:

- get prequalified **TODAY**: click [here](#) and follow the District's instructions
- check that your prequalification hasn't lapsed
- make a calendar reminder to submit your prequalification
