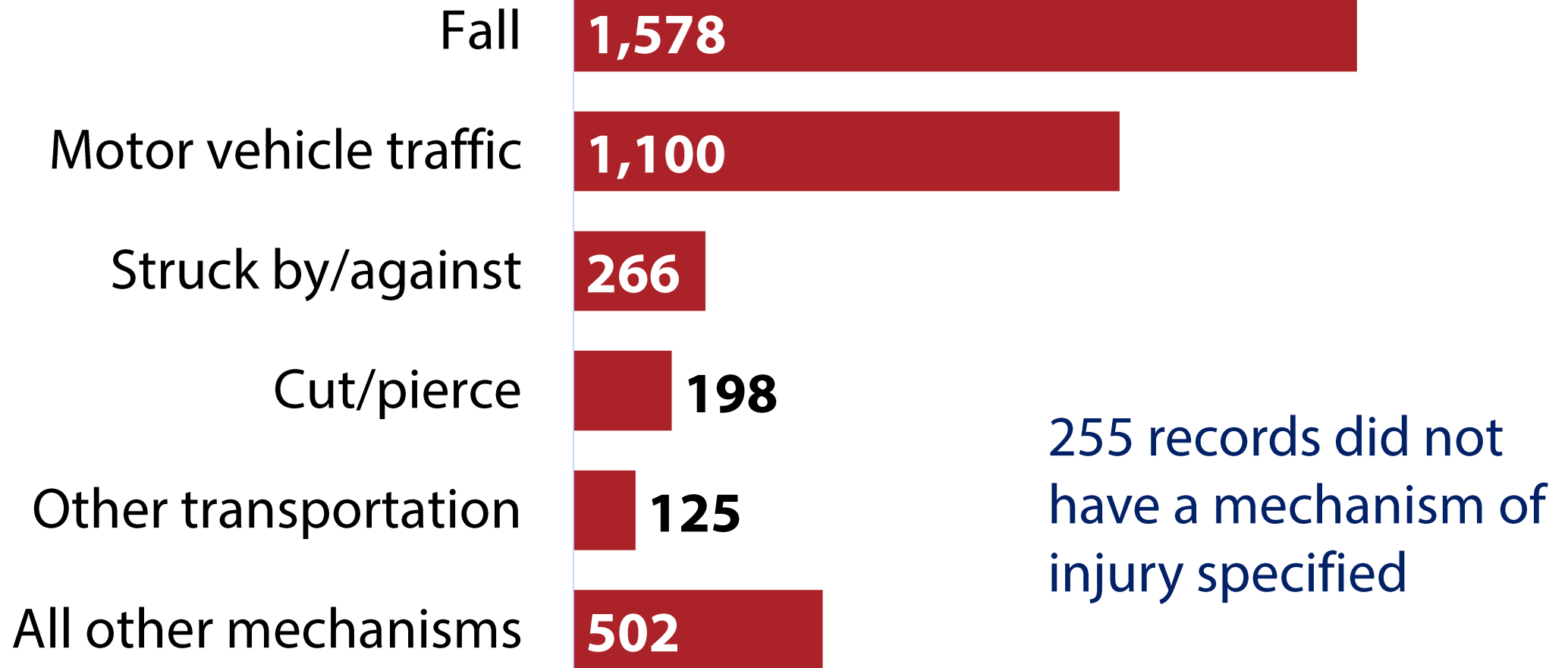
# Fall or motor vehicle traffic was the mechanism of injury for 71% of records

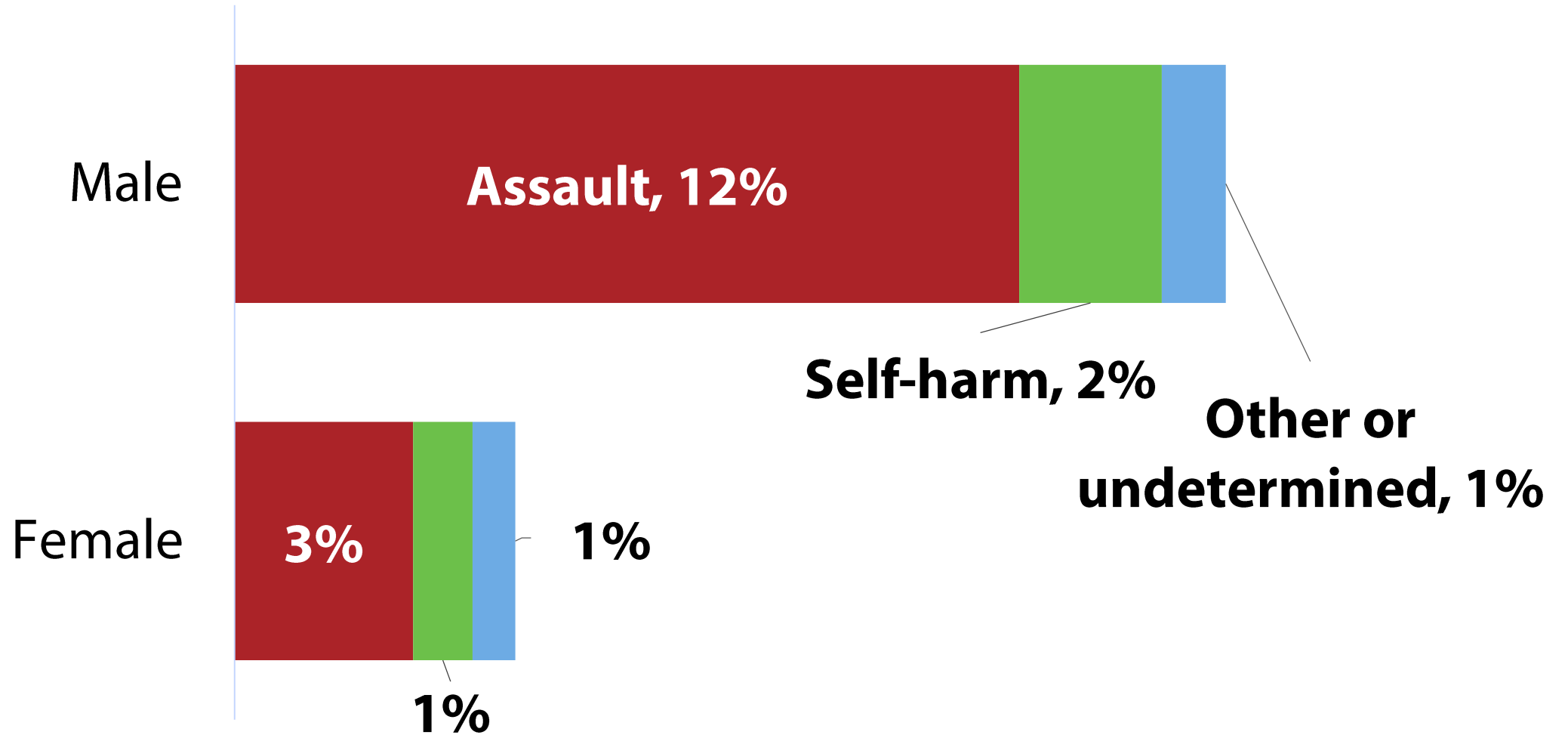

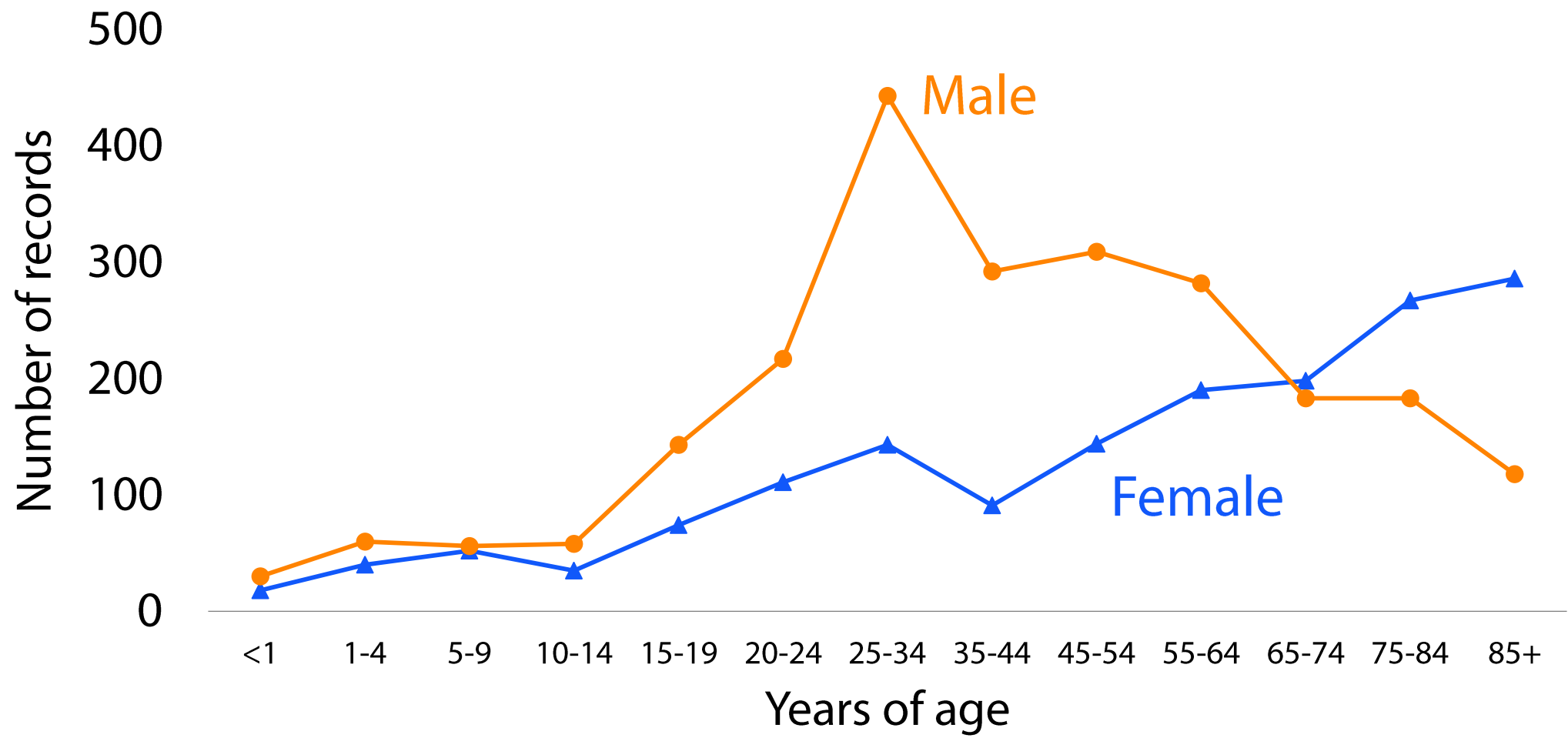
# Males were more likely to have injuries due to self-harm or assault



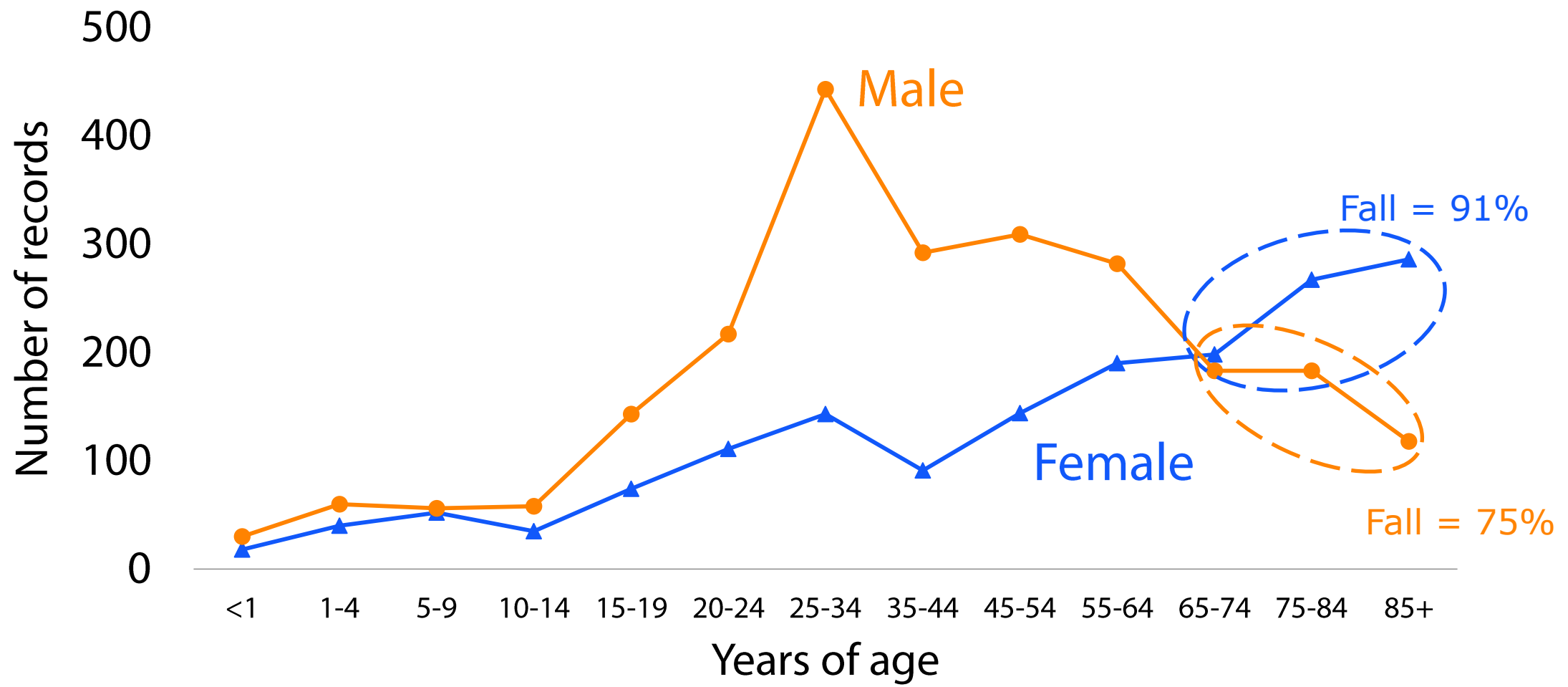
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# For ages <65 years, there were more records submitted for males for in every age group



# Most records for individuals 65 years and older had fall as the mechanism of injury



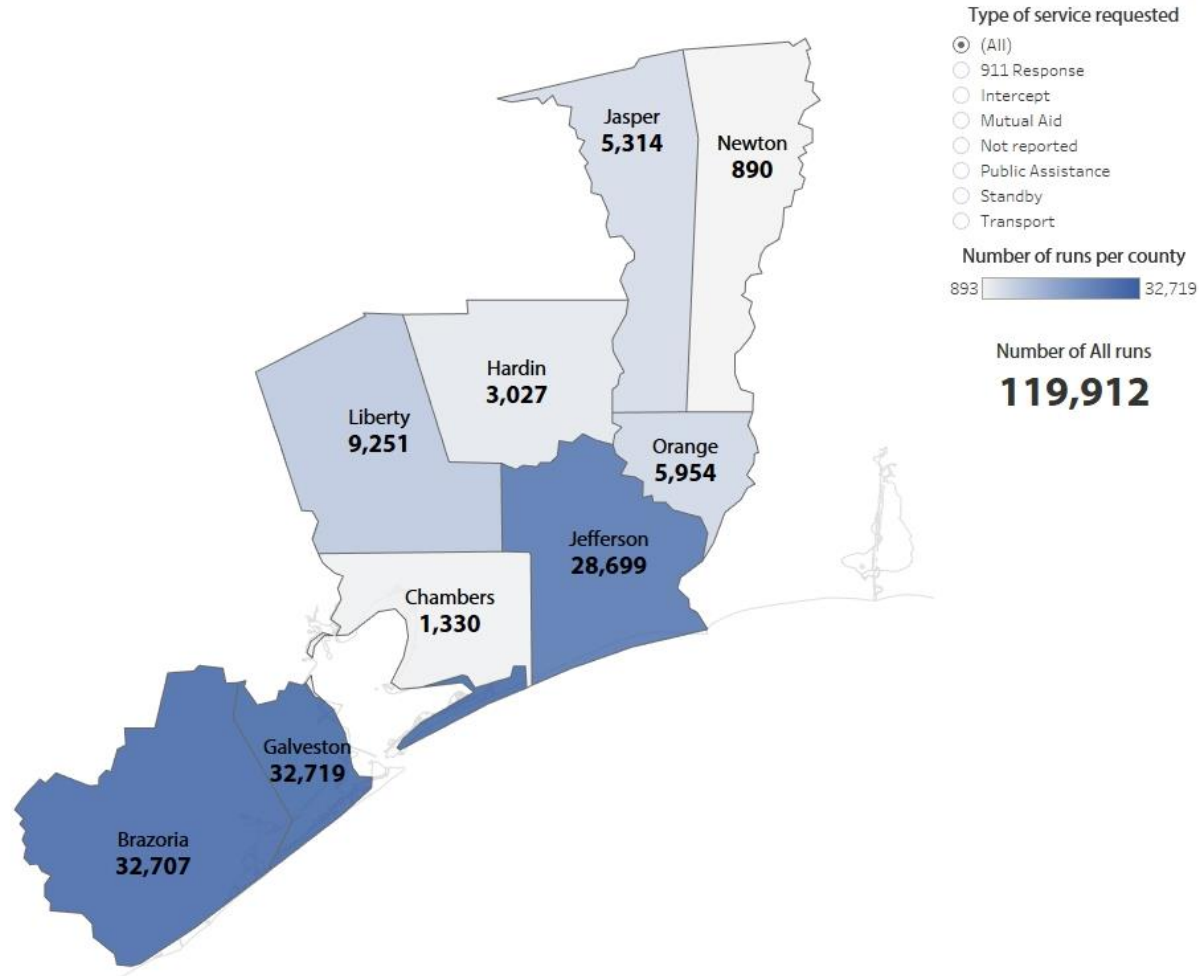
# There were 119,912 EMS runs reported for 2015 by entities in TSA R



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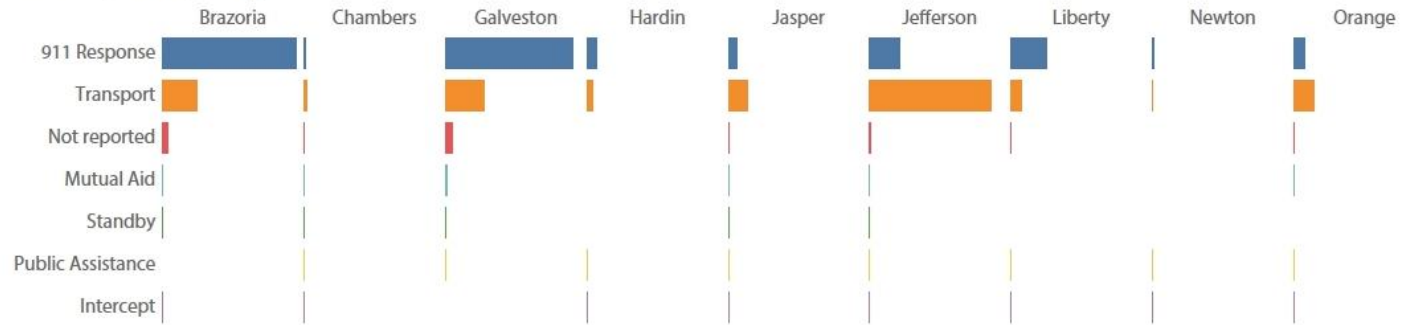
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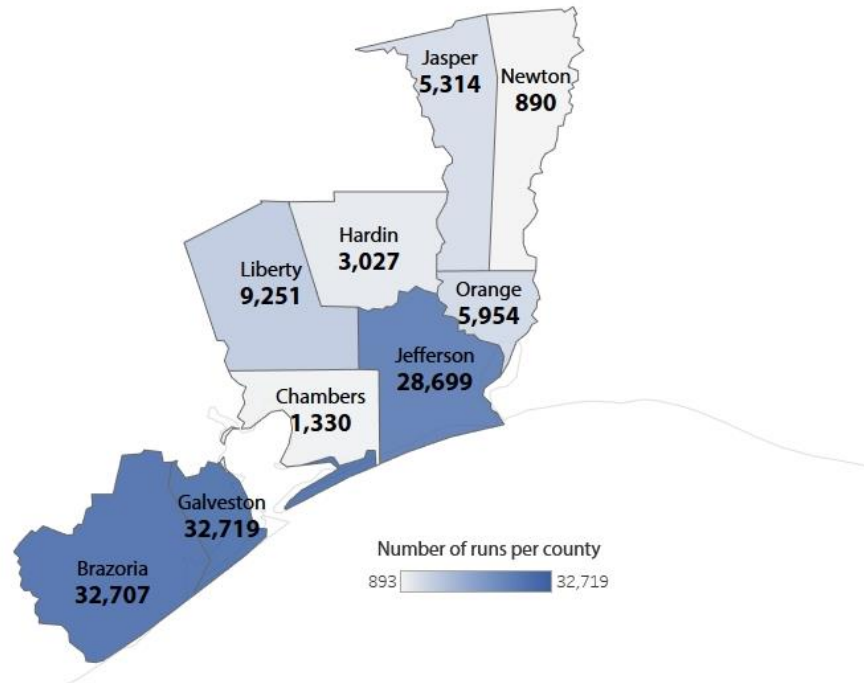
# The type of service requested varied by county

Type of service requested by county

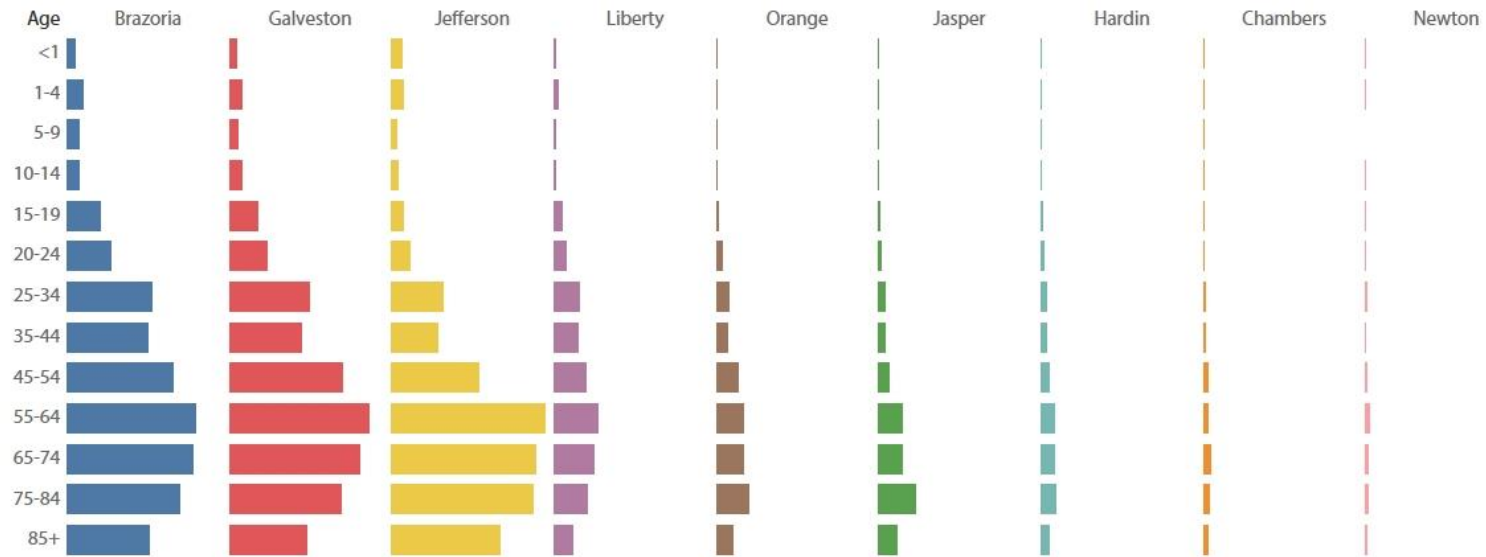

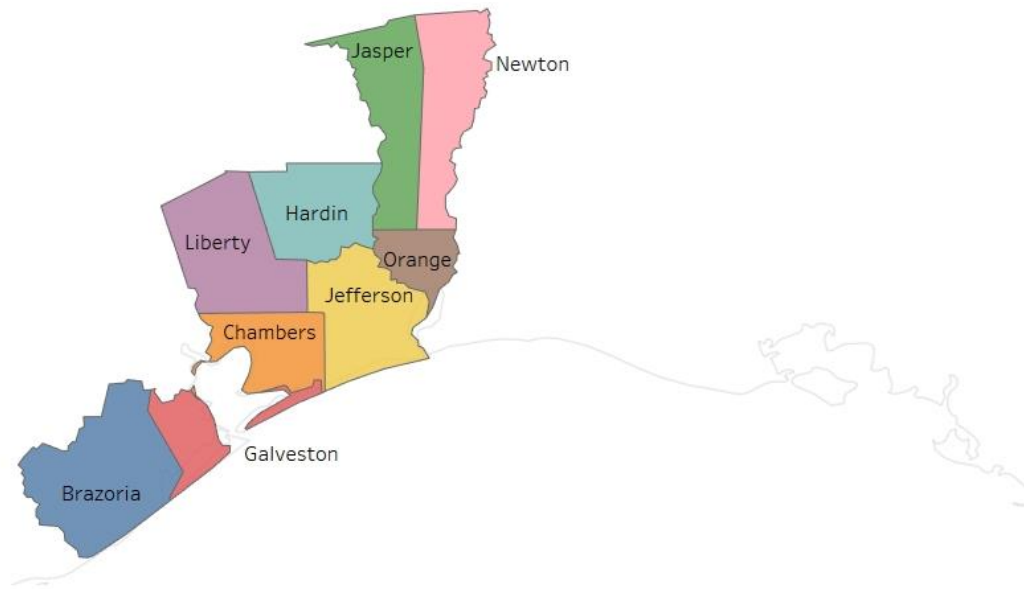
Bar lengths correspond to the number of runs by type of service
