# PREPARING FOR AUDITIONS

Fill out an audition form and review the rehearsal schedule. Parents and children should plan to be at SAAC for auditions by 5:30pm on both Monday and Tuesday, February 5-6. Everyone will be taught a song and some simple dance steps. Wear appropriate footwear and be prepared to move.

Two songs will be used in auditions; *Ev'rbody Wants to Be a Cat* and *Scales and Arpeggios*. We will teach the songs at the audition. For those that want to listen to and learn the songs before arriving for the audition, look online at the SAAC website for videos and the sheet music. Those wishing to be considered for a Primary Storyteller role will be asked to read at auditions - no preparation required.

Rehearsal Schedule: Doing a musical takes time and commitment from all involved. Please review the schedule to make sure you and your child can make the commitment to the project. Some roles, i.e., Country Dogs, Alley Cats may not be required to attend every rehearsal. Further information on scheduling will be provided by the directing team. Accepting a role acknowledges that you agree to the commitment required.

### A WORD ABOUT CASTING FROM THE DIRECTORS...

Disney's The Aristocats KIDS allows a great deal of flexibility in casting. In our show, only Duchess, O'Malley and Madame are gender-specific roles. For this reason we will be considering all auditioning actors for all roles. All races and ethnic groups are encouraged to audition. All roles in this show require singing.

Two songs will be used in auditions; Ev'rbody Wants to Be a Cat and Scales and Arpeggios. We will teach the songs at the audition. For those that want to listen to and learn the songs before arriving for the audition, look online at the SAAC website for videos and the sheet music. Those wishing to be considered for a Primary Storyteller role will be asked to read at the audition – no preparation required.

**Thomas O'Malley** is the charming and charismatic lead alley cat. He lives as a free spirit with no attachments but secretly desires to be part of a family. This cat flirts with Duchess and protects the kittens. Thomas must be a strong actor, singer, and mover.

**Duchess** is the elegant and nurturing mother of the Aristokittens. She is an older cat who serves as a maternal figure. Duchess works closely with O'Malley once the kittens find themselves out of Madame's protection. She must be a strong actor and mover.

**Edgar** is the villainous butler of Madame. He's allergic to the pampered Aristocats and secretly hates tending to them. Edgar must have comedic timing, singing skills, and be unafraid to be mean to the kittens.

**Toulouse and Berlioz** are Duchess's sons. Toulouse yearns to be seen as tougher than he is. Berlioz is a sidekick of Toulouse. These cats have a lot of stage time, but work as a trio with Marie.

**Marie** is the spirited and sassy daughter of Duchess. She is the youngest child and a charmer just like her mother. She works as a trio with Toulouse and Berlioz.

**Roquefort** is the naïve yet ultimately brave house mouse who overcomes his fears and saves the Aristokittens from Edgar. He finds himself confronting the Aristocats, but isn't quite sure of himself. Roquefort must be portrayed as innocent and frightened.

**Madame** is the eccentric and kind human owner of the Aristocats who loves her pets more than anything else in the world. She wants to give everything she has to her kittens, which makes Edgar jealous.

**General Napoleon and Private Lafayette** are two country dogs in a comedic power struggle throughout the show. Napoleon is the power-hungry leader and Lafayette the not-so-subservient private. This comic duo feeds off of each other and must work together.

**Vichy and Soisse** are two privates in the dog army who report to General Napoleon.

**Amelia and Abigail** are the two bold geese sisters who rescue O'Malley from the river and lead the way out of the country back to Paris.

**Scat Cat** is the jazzy leader of the Alley Cat narrators. Scat is ultra hip and enjoys introducing the Aristocats to jazz music. Scar must be a singer who is unafraid to go over-the-top.
