And see the brook, and feel the gentle breeze.



Standing on the promises of God



But is blessed if we trust and obey.



*But my horn shalt thou exalt like the horn of an unicorn: I shall be anointed with fresh oil. (Psalm 92:10)*

God anoints His people and by that (anointing) empowers His servants to carry out God's assigned tasks. It is imperative to note that without God's anointing the tasks of God cannot be executed on the Earth as natural energy is grossly insufficient, inapplicable, ineffective and useless to carry out spiritual tasks or assignment.

About God's assigned task to Zerubbabel, the Bible says, *"This is the word of the Lord unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by my spirit, saith the Lord of hosts. Who art thou, O great mountain? before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shoutings, crying, Grace, grace unto it. Moreover the word of the Lord came unto me, saying, The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house; his hands shall also finish it; and thou shalt know that the Lord of hosts hath sent me unto you. (Zech. 4:6-8 KJV).* In the context of God's assigned task to Zerubbabel to lead the re-building of the Temple at Jerusalem upon the return of the exiles from Babylon; God had cautioned and encouraged him not to depend on his might or power to execute the *spiritual assignment* of re-building God's Temple but on God's Spirit. We must gain this truth less we frail our nerves to perform spiritual assignments. It is incongruent as inapplicable to so approach God's assignment. This is the necessary need for the Anointing – to perform God's commanded task. We must embrace this truth.

About the Work and the Ministry of our Blessed Lord Jesus, the Bible says, *"God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him."* (Acts 10:38 KJV). Notice, the Anointing of God preceded the Ministry and working of our Lord Jesus Christ.



He was first Anointed ahead of going around to do *"good and healing all who were under the power of the devil"*. Anyone will become annoying without the anointing in the Work of the Ministry. It is the Anointing that validates the Ministry tasks. It is the mark of God's presence on a Work or Ministry; notice the Bible says of Jesus *"...how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him."*

Now when we are anointed with *fresh oil*; it's a noble elevation to new experience in God for new or greater exploits in Ministry. Fresh oil mandates one for a fresh, new or expanded Ministry function or assignment. Akin to being awarded a work promotion (in our natural or secular work life) with fresh or new work assignment or functional role, the impetus of new salary or pay is the necessary *oil* to lubricate or motivate one's energy to assume the new role. The new salary or pay *oils* one's zeal and enthusiasm to assume higher or elevated responsibility without feeling of abuse or exploitation but rather heightened sense of accomplishment and self-realization. Praise God.

King David in his life reign was anointed three times, first amidst his brethren (1 Sam. 16:13 KJV); was anointed at Hebron as king of Judah (2 Sam. 2:1-4 KJV) and again at Hebron as king of Israel; each *anointing* having David assume greater and elevated functionality for God and service to God's people. I pray that God fresh oil will usher you and I to new and elevated responsibility for God and His Kingdom in Jesus Name. Congratulations on the Fresh oil. Amen!

## Spiritual Transaction

No,' they replied, 'there may not be enough for both us and you. Instead, go to those who sell oil and buy some for yourselves.' (Matt. 25:9 KJV)

We must be willing to pay the price required, to take delivery of God's anointing. Ignorance and deferred obedience cannot be excuses to keep us from paying this price (Matt 28:8-13). We gain value by the level of exchange we are willing to give in order to receive God's anointing. Believing, for instance is the price required to receive God's Salvation and in paying this price wisdom is required (Acts 16:30-31). Our willingness to pay this spiritual price gives us a rooting in the spirit and stops the devil from destroying the works of God in our lives. ### The Cost of the Oil


- 1) Thirst- Express your need to find God's anointing Is 55:1-33.
- 2) Emptiness- Create room, capacity to be filled by God 2 Kings 4:2
- 3) Find fresh oil- Ps 107:9

We must be ready to empty myself and hunger after God to receive and generate more fresh oil, being rooted in God.

*"About the oil in Matt. 25:9 KJV; the wise answered, saying, not so; ...go ye rather to them that sell, and buy for yourselves".*

The unwise or foolish were unaware that the oil must be bought (not given free) and so were excluded for lacking oil at the critical time of their need for it. We must search the Scriptures to gain truth about what is required of us to trade for our spiritual needs. It is well."
