**ViroDecon by Rocky Mountain Restoration is a service that specializes in virus, mold and bacterial decontamination in commercial and residential spaces along the Front Range of Colorado. RMR has been dealing with toxic environments for over 12 years.**

## What we do:



### Preventative Disinfection

#### Services: (Level 1)

Slow the spread of viruses and harmful bacteria like MRSA through periodic disinfection. We will do a complete disinfection of high traffic areas with special disinfectants that do not damage metals and fabrics and are certified by the EPA to kill viruses and bacteria.

### Preventative Disinfection

#### Services: (Level 2)

At level 2 we conduct a full cleaning of all surfaces including walls, ceilings, floors and air. This takes longer than level one and is recommended at times when there is a harmful pathogen outbreak in your region. This is a wet decontamination service with some dry techniques used

for special sensitive materials.

### Disaster Response: (Level 3)

When a facility has had a known exposure to an infected individual with a serious pathogen (H1N1, Coronavirus, Ebola) we have our third and highest level of response. After first responders have been called in to remove personnel from your facility we are ready to respond and get your facility decontaminated through a single treatment or series of treatments.

### Common spaces in need of treatment

- **Schools and Daycare Centers**
- **Workplace and Hospitality (office buildings and hotels)**
- **Vehicle and Supply Chain (trucks, warehouses, goods)**
- **Medical Offices (doctor and dentist offices)**




### We decontaminate spaces with:

- Coronavirus
- Seasonal Influenza
- H1N1 Flu
- Both enveloped and non-enveloped viruses
- Ebola (EBOV)
- Toxic fungi and mold
- Bacterial outbreaks
- Other hazardous pathogens

*We use EPA and OSHA approved processes in our materials and procedures.*

### Assessment Process:

Our assessment process involves looking for factors like hard vs. soft materials, high ceilings and low crawl spaces. Filling out the New Customer Form at the end of this packet will help us begin the assessment of your facility. Before service begins we may visit your building or just need a description depending on the level of service and other factors.



### A Bio-friendly process:

We use a bio-friendly process which leaves nothing more than a thin film of common table salt as a residue. Our process is not corrosive to metals as you find with bleach treatments. Other processes like ozone treatments can have lasting cancer-causing particles as ozone reacts with common chemicals. We only use EPA registered antimicrobial solutions. We may use several types of treatments depending on the

materials in your facility. Hard surfaces and soft surfaces are treated differently.

### Evidence-based results

We offer several types of testing including swab tests, viral lab tests, air quality tests and mold spore tests depending on the nature of your emergency. In Level 3 service we may use testing to determine the effectiveness of the decontamination. In some large jobs a microbiologist may be there as an independent source of information and as a quality control.

## Safety

Your site may require our **Level 1 preventative treatments** or our full **Level 3 emergency system** involving clean rooms and removal of known infected material. We follow federal guidelines in all levels of decontamination to ensure pathogens do not spread, and we offer testing and follow up decontaminations to ensure a clean environment.

**We are OSHA certified** in health and safety. We also hold an IICRC certification in Applied Microbial Remediation, Health and Safety and other categories.

## Certified levels of service:



### LEVEL 1: Preventative Service

- 4 times monthly during flu season
- 2 times monthly during flu season
- Once monthly during flu season

Get your **high traffic areas**, both hard and soft surfaces disinfected.

### LEVEL 2: Full service preventative Service

Get **all surfaces** and **air** treated. Level 2 uses wet decontamination on hard and most soft surfaces with special treatments like UV for certain materials that cannot be misted with wet solutions.

### Level 3: Known harmful pathogens, emergency service

Get the highest level of service for serious situations.

### Level 3 service add-ons include:

- Bigger teams: Expandable disinfectant equipment operator units with unit managers
- An on-sight microbiologist for quality control and overseeing samples
- Multiple treatments to increase confidence in customers
- Removal of infected material and destruction of that material, this may include items such as upholstery, blood and tissue, etc.

All levels of service come with a **certificate of completion** which may be presented to customers or insurance companies as proof of disinfection. In Level 3 service we may provide test results along with a final report.
