⇒ Questions and Answers:

Q1: Why is it important for a country to develop as much industry as possible?

Ans: Developing industry is so much more profitable than agriculture as industrial products are far more valuable as exports.

Q2: Where are the sulphur mines located in Pakistan?

Ans: The sulphur mines are located in Koh-i-Sultan range in Balochistan.

Q3: Where are the cement-manufacturing plants located in Pakistan?

Ans: They are located in Khairpur, Chakwal, D.G. Khan and Hub, Balochistan.

Q4: What is the difference between Exports and Imports?

Ans: Exports are goods which a country sells to other countries. Whereas, Imports are the goods which a country buys from other countries.

Q5: Differentiate between a cottage and small-scale industry.

Ans: A cottage industry is a small industrial unit which the owner and his or her family run themselves.

A small-scale industry is one in which the fixed capital investment is below Rs 2 million.
