The InTech Center has partnered with the Inland/Desert Apprenticeship Committee, comprised of local manufacturers, for trainees to apply and register for apprenticeship as an Industrial Mechanic or Industrial Maintenance Electrician.

Trainees need to meet eligibility qualifications.

QUALIFICATIONS NEEDED TO APPLY:

- **Application** – Completely filled out
- **Most-Up-to-Date Resume**
- **High School Diploma / GED** (copy)
- **Provide eligibility to work in the U.S. I-9 documentation**
 - Valid Photo ID, Social Security Card OR U.S. Passport
- **Assessments**

Trainees must:

 - Pass the CASAS Reading Comprehension and Math test at a tenth grade level; and
 - Pass the hands-on lab practical – Electrical & Mechanical (25 minutes each) score at minimum 70%
- **Attendance** – Trainee attendance records will be evaluated and will factor into the overall apprentice candidate ranking.
- **Interview** – Trainees will be interviewed by an industry panel who will ask questions about their interest, commitment level and aptitude for the apprenticeship occupations
