WOOD MILL DEMONSTRATION - PARKING LOT

TOMMY PARMITER OPERATES OUT OF RUSTBURG, VA AND OWNS A TREE SERVICE COMPANY WITH A PASSION FOR MAKING THE MOST OUT OF URBAN WOOD. FOR VARIOUS REASONS, VERY FEW LOGS FROM TREES TAKEN DOWN INSIDE AN URBAN AREA ARE CAPABLE OF BEING SOLD TO A TRADITIONAL SAWMILL. TOO MANY HISTORIC TREES IN LYNCHBURG ARE LEFT TO ROT. HE INVESTED IN THE LARGEST PORTABLE BANDSAW MILL MADE IN AMERICA TO DO HIS PART IN FINDING SUSTAINABLE USES FOR THIS WOOD.

POND MANAGEMENT 101 - MAKING THE MOST OF YOUR FARM POND - Room 172

DAN MICHAELSON IS A FISHERIES BIOLOGISTS FOR THE VIRGINIA DEPARTMENT OF GAME AND INLAND FISHERIES. ONE OF HIS RESPONSIBILITIES IS THE MANAGEMENT OF SMALL IMPOUNDMENTS (PONDS). KEY TOPICS WILL INCLUDE PROPER POND LAYOUT AND DESIGN, FISH STOCKING, MANAGEMENT STRATEGIES, AND COMMON PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED BY POND OWNERS.

STRIPED BASS FISHING - Room 150

MIKE SNEAD PREVIOUS FISHING GUIDE AND SPORTING GOODS STOREOWNER, WILL PROVIDE PARTICIPANTS WITH INFORMATION ABOUT THE DIFFERENT TECHNIQUES AND TYPES OF TACKLE NEEDED TO SUCCESSFULLY CATCH LANDLOCKED STRIPED BASS (STRIPER, LINESIDER, ROCKFISH). THIS WORKSHOP WILL INCLUDE INFORMATION ABOUT STRIPED BASS SEASONAL PATTERNS AND THE VARIOUS TYPES OF TACKLE, FISHING TECHNIQUES AND RIGGING OPTIONS APPROPRIATE FOR CATCHING THEM. THIS WORKSHOP WILL COVER THE SELECTION, RIGGING AND PRESENTATION OPTIONS FOR LIVE BAIT AS WELL AS MANY OF THE DIFFERENT ARTIFICIAL LURES SEASONALLY APPROPRIATE FOR STRIPERS. IT WILL ALSO PROVIDE INFORMATION ABOUT SOME OF THE MORE COMMON SUPPLEMENTAL EQUIPMENT USED TO CATCH, KEEP AND PRESENT LIVE BAIT. WHETHER YOU ARE A NEW ANGLER INTERESTED IN LEARNING ABOUT THE VARIOUS TECHNIQUES AND TYPES OF EQUIPMENT USED TO CATCH STRIPED BASS OR AN EXPERIENCED ANGLER, THIS WORKSHOP WILL PROVIDE INFORMATION THAT WILL MAKE YOU MORE KNOWLEDGEABLE AND HELP MAKE YOUR NEXT FISHING TRIP MORE PRODUCTIVE.

INTRODUCTION TO BASIC CANOEING AND KAYAKING - Room 161,

BARRY TYREE HAS 35 YEARS EXPERIENCE PADDLING WHITE WATER, LAKES, OCEAN WATERS, SWAMPS, AND CREEKS. BARRY HAS ALSO BEEN A PADDLING INSTRUCTOR FOR GUIDE SERVICES. THIS SEMINAR WILL COVER BASIC PADDLING TECHNIQUES WITH AN EMPHASIS ON STREAM PADDLING BUT WILL PROVIDE THE BASICS FOR ANY TYPE OF WATER. LEARN EIGHT IMPORTANT PADDLE STROKES NECESSARY FOR PROPER CRAFT HANDLING, HOW TO READ FAST WATER AND HOW TO DETERMINE THE BEST ROUTE SELECTION WHILE NAVIGATING THROUGH FAST WATER. FIND OUT HOW TO AVOID CAPSIZING AND WHAT TO DO IN THE EVENT OF A CAPSIZE ALONG WITH OTHER BASIC SAFETY TIPS. WHILE THIS SEMINAR IS DIRECTED PRIMARILY AT CANOEISTS, THE INFORMATION PRESENTED WILL ALSO BENEFIT KAYAKERS.
