- 3. Rowers travel counter clockwise, Paddlers go clockwise and should watch out for rowers!
- 4. Check for other boats if using slalom buoys.
- 5. Rinse & Dry boats after use.
- 6. If a boat is damaged report it. If you damaged it, help pay for it.

- 7. Never place a boat or ama on gravel or asphalt.
- 8. Put away hose if there is no one else on the water. Make sure both ends are in the bucket.
- 9. Clean up after yourself. Empty trash if it's full. We have no janitor!
- 10. Sign out when you leave.
- 11. Turn out lights and lock up EVERYTHING!
