

Short term housing may include a 3 day, 30 day or 90 day stay in one of our temporary facilities.


This may include an RV type trailer complete with bed, dishes, bathroom, shower, refrigerator, stove, microwave, sink, water, electricity, and more.

Most people experience some kind of life crisis situation sooner or later. Those circumstances may include divorce, unemployment, arrest, incarceration, and eviction, to name a few.

Many of the people going through a crisis, find themselves homeless or left with a feeling of desperation. **We're here to help.** Our transitional housing program provides hope and partnership with people who have bounced back from their own life challenges.

Our leadership team includes both men and women with Bachelors in social work, Masters in Psychology, decades of Pastoral experience, Administrators from county jails, and more.

Our church is located between Hope Outreach and Our Daily Bread, where we currently serve over 100 people per year with some form of benevolent assistance.



### **Requirements for Residents:**

1. Application for the program can be found online at: [anewchurch.tv/ministries](http://anewchurch.tv/ministries)
2. Interview with a mentor / personal sponsor for initial assessment.
3. Commitment to meet daily for "life coaching" sessions that include devotions, job placement, counseling, GED testing, drivers license re-instatement, etc.
4. 1 hour per day of volunteer work at anew church which may include light duties such as painting, mowing, cleaning, office duties, etc.
5. Completion of the "Foundations" study guide that covers such topics as: attitudes, authorities, relationships, anger management, dealing with failure, temptations, and self acceptance.
6. Church attendance on Sunday is mandatory.
7. Contribution of 30% of job earnings toward your own personal "launch fund".



We believe that hard work is essential to success in every area of life. That includes success financially, emotionally, physically, and spiritually. The only way to achieve new goals is through accountability.

We will partner with the residents of our program to teach independent living by taking personal responsibility in every area of life.

Those who apply themselves and work hard will reap lasting benefits of this program. Many will break the cycle of continued consequences for blaming others, making excuses, and not taking personal responsibility for life.

Those who complete the program will experience a changed life, and live with the reward of being able to mentor and support others to bounce back from personal crisis.
