

CITY OF MINDEN CHAIN STORE LICENSE
ANNUAL TAX SCHEDULE

A chain or group having:

1) Not more than 10 stores	\$10 per store
2) More than 10, but not more than 35 stores	\$15 per store
3) More than 35, but not more than 50 stores	\$20 per store
4) More than 50, but not more than 75 stores	\$25 per store
5) More than 75, but not more than 100 stores	\$30 per store
6) More than 100, but not more than 125 stores	\$50 per store
7) More than 125, but not more than 150 stores	\$100 per store
8) More than 150, but not more than 175 stores	\$150 per store
9) More than 175, but not more than 200 stores	\$200 per store
10) More than 200, but not more than 225 stores	\$250 per store
11) More than 225, but not more than 250 stores	\$300 per store
12) More than 250, but not more than 275 stores	\$350 per store
13) More than 275, but not more than 300 stores	\$400 per store
14) More than 300, but not more than 400 stores	\$450 per store
15) More than 400, but not more than 500 stores	\$500 per store
16) More than 500 stores	\$550 per store

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1. Rate of Tax—The rate of tax is determined from the total retail stores operated under the same Franchise name and/or under the same general management, supervision, ownership or control, wherever located.
 2. Measure of Tax—The measure, or the amount of tax due the City of Minden, is determined by applying the rate of tax to the total retail stores in Minden.
 3. Example—If an operator of a total of 36 retail stores located in Texas, New York, Alabama & Louisiana operated 2 stores in Minden, La., the amount of chain store tax would be computed as follows: The license tax schedule above shows that the rate of tax on a chain of between 35 and 50 stores is \$20 per Minden store. Therefore, the amount of tax due would be 2 Minden stores at \$20 each or a total of \$40.
 4. This license is in addition to the Occupational License Tax required for operating business in the City of Minden.
