## Biography

Born and raised on Vancouver Island, Jeremy had a rural upbringing on the outskirts of Campbell River. His first career began at the age of 14, working as a deckhand on his father's commercial salmon troller, a job he continued for the next 8 summers. Jeremy was valedictorian of his 1984 high school graduating class. and a year later embarked on an eight month backpacking adventure, travelling throughout Europe and the Middle East, including a three month stint working on a kibbutz in Israel.

Jeremy began his second career in Victoria, entering the BC casino industry while it was still in it's infancy relocating to Vancouver in 1994. It was there that Jeremy started his third (and current) career in the BC film industry, working in the Grip department, a job he helped land because of his fishing experience, specifically, being able to tie knots.

In 2013 Jeremy decided to enter the provincial political arena, running as an independent MLA candidate and targeting voter apathy. He was then recruited in 2014 by the municipal Cedar Party to run for Vancouver city council. In 2016 he was again recruited by the provincial party YPP and ran as their candidate in 2016 Vancouver Mount-Pleasant by-election. This broad base of experience and the opportunity to use the knowledge he has gained is why Jeremy is excited to be back as a founding member of the People's Party of Canada. ## A People's Party Government will:

- Reinstatement of the fair disability pension for our Veterans as previously provided for by the *Pension Act*.

- Withdraw from the Paris Accord and stop sending billions of dollars to developing countries to help them reduce their emissions. End the carbon tax
- End the dairy cartels allowing Canada's dairy, egg and poultry farmers to thrive and sell their products internationally
- Reduce the total amount of equalization payments to provinces, and make sure that only the provinces with the greatest needs benefit from it
