PUBLIC HEARING: ORDINANCES FOR FINAL ADOPTION

Ordinance No. 2019-001: An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of Carencro to locate suitable real property and negotiate for purchase of same by the city.

Ordinance No. 2019-002: An ordinance authorizing the purchase and relocation of a house located at 107 South Michaud Street in Carencro, Louisiana.

RESOLUTION:

Resolution 2019-002: A resolution of the Carencro City Council amending the 2018/2019 TIF District Sales Tax operating budget providing \$100,000.00 for the purchase of an historic house, purchase of property for relocation and move expenses as well as funds for construction to preserve the historic structure.

Mayor Brasseaux informed the council and public that he received a phone call from the home owners Tim and Jennifer Guilbeau stating that due to issues with a contractor

stating that they had a contract with him they would prefer to wait to resolve the situation before proceeding with the sale of the house.

City Attorney Jerry Mallet advised that the Guilbeau's could signed an affidavit stating that no contract has been signed with the contractor and they wish to proceed with the sale of the house to the City of Carencro.

Mayor Brasseaux asked the council to table both ordinances up for final adoption as well as the resolution until the regular council meeting to be held on February 18, 2019.

Councilmember Sinegal made a motion to table both ordinances and the resolution; seconded by Councilmember Babineaux; motion approved.

Councilmember Babineaux made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Councilmember Sinegal; motion approved.
