FACES OF THE POOR—2019 The St. Vincent de Paul Conference here in Montgomery operates out of Holy Spirit, however we do have members and/or people that support us, here at St. Peter's Church. Where does our money and time go?

Let me share one story A family of 7, Mom is a Liver transplant recipient and Dad has complications from a recent ruptured colon. The family has 5 children from 20 to 13. They are very blessed in many ways, one being the house they live in, is a family home and paid off. (Of course, they still have insurance and property taxes every year.) Neither parent can work, only the mother receives disability and the father has had to quit his job. The oldest child is attending school at Trenholm and the younger ones all attend school. They basically get by until they have an emergency. Their washing machine went out a couple months ago and watching YouTube videos they were able to repair it themselves; however, that did not last long and the motor gave out and they did not have emergency money. Since the Mom has had a liver transplant, she must be very careful with anything that might cause an infection or a cold. With 7 people in the family that makes a lot of dirty clothes. We were able to get a nice, used washing machine for \$360 which was delivered and set up for free. The family was most appreciative. We will start taking food to this family once a month.
