RELIGIOUS EDUCATION BEGINS THIS SUNDAY!! Please bring students grades K-12 at 9 AM for registration and introduction for their classes! We are hoping for 100% participation and are excited to get to know students and their families better! Please keep in mind we still need a few more teachers/volunteers!

WE ARE EXCITED TO ANNOUNCE that beginning in the fall session of Religious Education, the high school students (grades 9-12) will be studying Ascension Press's "You: Life, Love, and the Theology of the Body." The lessons in the program consist of age-appropriate videos, exercises, and discussions about love, marriage, and sexual relations. The program is intended to show how Catholic teaching on these subjects makes more sense, and is ultimately more attractive, than many of the messages that are directed at teenagers by our contemporary culture. The class will be led by Rick Harris and Rebekah Derdoski. We will hold an introductory session for STUDENTS AND PARENTS on Sunday, September 15 at 9:00am. There will be a student handbook as well as a parent guide distributed so that parents may be aware of what is being taught in the class and may discuss the material with their children. Be assured that the material is fully consistent with Catholic teaching and morals. It is based on a series of talks given by St. John Paul II which he entitled, "The Theology of the Body." If parents have any concerns or questions, please attend the introductory session before making a decision as to your child's participation. The topics being addressed in this series are things consistently brought up by our students. We are excited to be able to share the Church's teachings with them through this program.

SINCE THE INFAMOUS ROE V. WADE DECISION IN 1973, more than 60 million unborn babies have been murdered in the United States—this is over three times greater than the combined numbers of Jewish people murdered in German concentration camps, Russians murdered in Stalin's gulags, Chinese people murdered in the Great Leap Forward, Cambodians murdered by the Khmer Rouge, and Tutsis murdered in the Rwandan genocide. Forty Days for Life is a semi-annual period when faithful Christians are asked to pray for an end to this tragic and ongoing crime against humanity. This fall, 40 Days for Life will begin on September 25 and conclude on November 3. During this period, we are asked not only to pray individually and in our homes and churches, but also to join with many others in prayer in the vacant lot across the street from Montgomery's abortion clinic. St. Peter parishioners are asked to cover the 12 hours between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Saturday, October 5, in that lot. It is now owned by our good friends, Life on Wheels Alabama, and is a safe place to stand and pray without being harassed. Can you volunteer to take one hour at this lot, either alone or in the company of other family members and friends? We will have sign up sheets available after the 10:30 Mass on Sunday, September 22 and Sunday, September 29.
