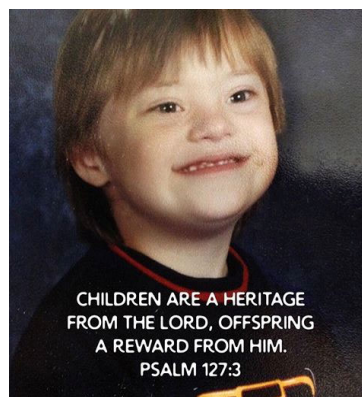

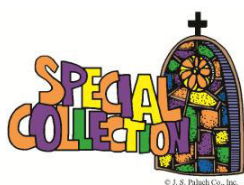

COMPENDIUM OF THE CATECHISM OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

PART ONE—PROFESSION OF FAITH SECTION TWO—THE PROFESSION OF THE CHRISTIAN FAITH CHAPTER TWO—I BELIEVE IN JESUS CHRIST THE ONLY SON OF GOD

83. *In what sense is Jesus the Only Begotten Son of God?*

Jesus is the Son of God in a unique and perfect way. At the time of his Baptism and his Transfiguration, the voice of the Father designated Jesus as his “beloved Son.” In presenting himself as the Son who “knows the Father” (Matthew 11:27), Jesus affirmed his singular and eternal relationship with God his Father. He is “the Only Begotten Son of God” (1 John 4:9), the second Person of the Blessed Trinity. He is the central figure of apostolic preaching. The apostles saw “his glory as of the Only Begotten of the Father” (John 1:14).

COME AND LEARN ABOUT THE WINDOW PROJECT Sunday, September 22, following the 10:30 AM Mass, Mr. Stephen Frei will be in the parish hall to discuss our window project. This is an opportunity to learn about the scope of the project and to get any questions you might have answered. The windows were originally built by the Emil Frei Company out of St. Louis and we're fortunate to have the folks that made the widows back to do the restoration.

FORTY DAYS FOR LIFE is a semi-annual period when faithful Christians are asked to pray for an end to this tragic and ongoing crime against humanity. This fall, 40 Days for Life will begin on September 25 and conclude on November 3. During this period, we are asked not only to pray individually and in our homes and churches, but also to join with many others in prayer in the vacant lot across the street from Montgomery's abortion clinic. St. Peter parishioners are asked to cover the 12 hours between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Saturday, October 5, in that lot. It is now owned by our good friends, Life on Wheels Alabama, and is a safe place to stand and pray without being harassed. Can you volunteer to take one hour at this lot, either alone or in the company of other family members and friends? We will have sign up sheets available after the 10:30 Mass on Sunday, September 22 and Sunday, September 29.

SHOTS FOR FLU SEASON will be given out the weekend of October 12 & 13 by a licensed professional. Shots will be given for pneumonia, flu and shingles. Medical forms will be at the back of the Church for those interested.
