CHAPTER TWO—I BELIEVE IN JESUS CHRIST

THE ONLY SON OF GOD

84. *What is the meaning of the title "Lord"?*

In the Bible this title regularly designated God as Sovereign. Jesus ascribed this title to himself and revealed his divine sovereignty by his power over nature, over demons, over sin, and over death, above all by his own Resurrection. The first Christian creeds proclaimed that the power, the honor, and the glory that are due to God the Father also belong to Jesus: God "has given him the name which is above every other name" (Philippians 2:9). He is the Lord of the world and of history, the only One to whom we must completely submit our personal freedom.

FORTY DAYS FOR LIFE is a semi-annual period when faithful Christians are asked to pray for an end to this tragic and ongoing crime against humanity. This fall, 40 Days for Life will begin on September 25 and conclude on November 3. During this period, we are asked not only to pray individually and in our homes and churches, but also to join with many others in prayer in the vacant lot across the street from Montgomery's abortion clinic. St. Peter parishioners are asked to cover the 12 hours between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Saturday, October 5, in that lot. It is now owned by our good friends, Life on Wheels Alabama, and is a safe place to stand and pray without being harassed. Can you volunteer to take one hour at this lot, either alone or in the company of other family members and friends? We will have sign up sheets available after the 10:30 Mass on Sunday, September 22 and Sunday, September 29.

SHOTS FOR FLU SEASON will be given out the weekend of October 12 & 13 by a licensed professional. Shots will be given for pneumonia, flu and shingles. Medical forms will be at the back of the Church for those interested.

FIND HEALING AFTER ABORTION If the emotional and spiritual wounds of a past abortion have been sapping the faith, love and joy from your life, consider a Rachel's Vineyard weekend retreat to find healing and peace. Rachel's Vineyard is a safe place to renew, rebuild and redeem hearts broken by abortion.
