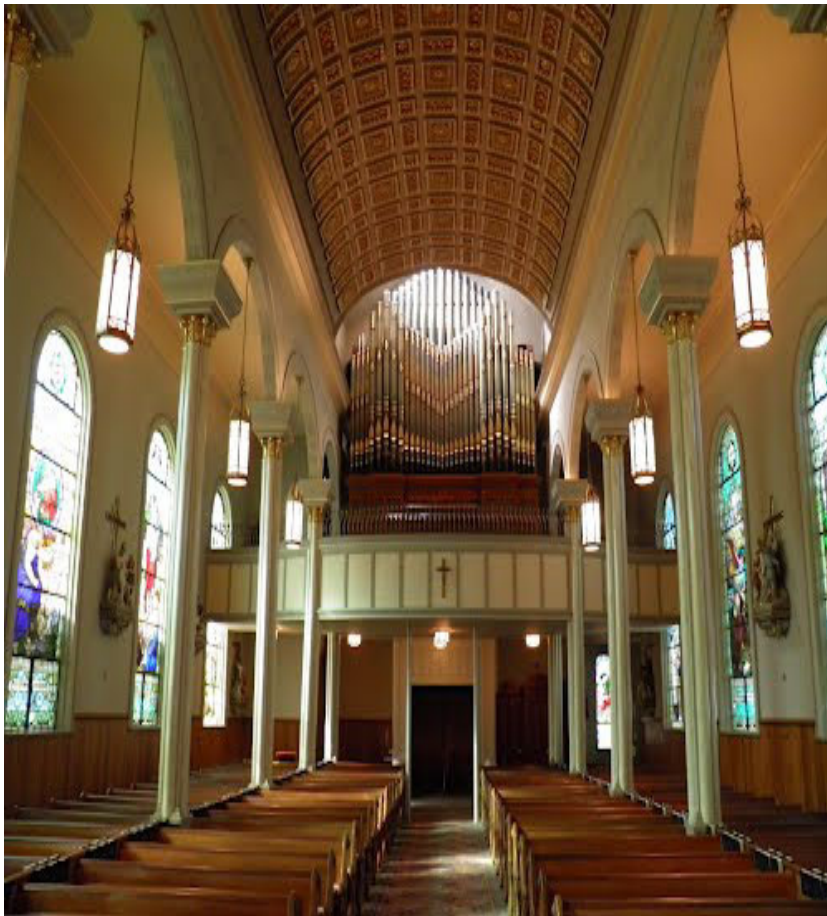

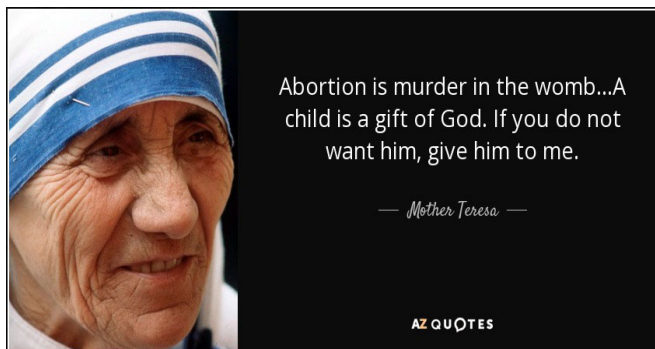

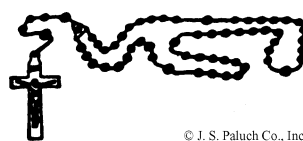

85. *Why did the Son of God become man?*
