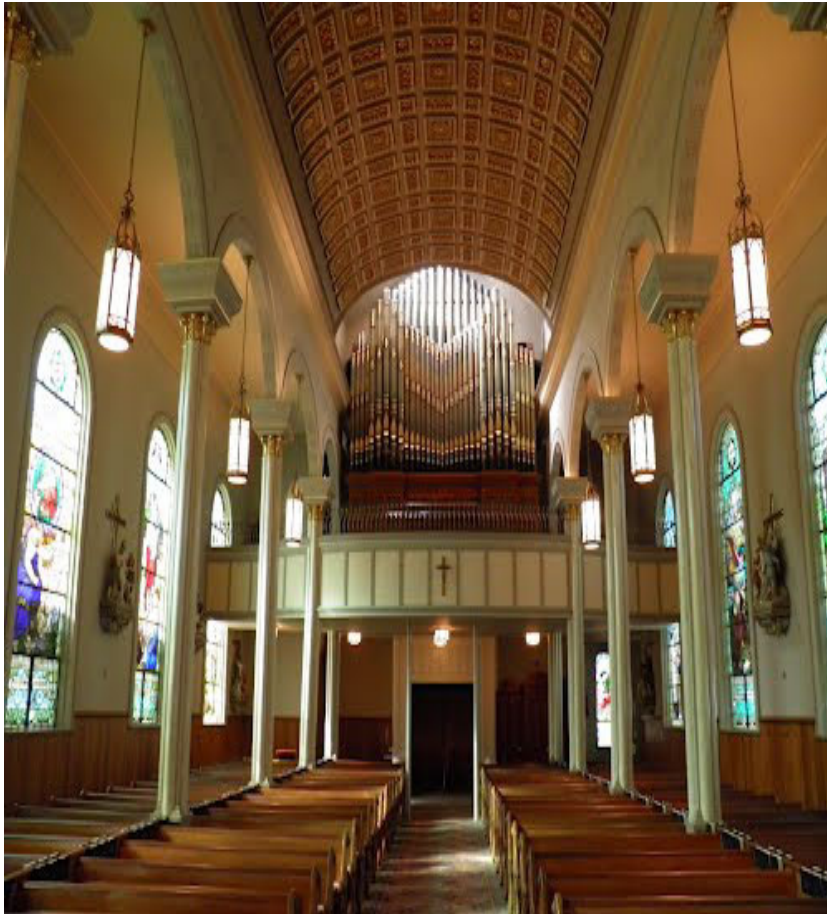

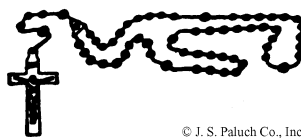
PRAYER LINE MINISTRY

CHAPTER TWO—I BELIEVE IN JESUS CHRIST

THE ONLY SON OF GOD

86. *What does the word “Incarnation” mean?*
