

COVID-19 Safety Guidelines for Litter Pick-up Volunteers

1. Educate yourself on how the COVID-19 spreads:

2. If you are feeling sick, have experienced shortness of breath, had a fever in the last 14 days or have been around someone who is sick, please stay home and rest.
3. While gloves and masks are recommended, we cannot guarantee their effectiveness.
4. It is recommended that household groups complete cleanups together to prevent the spread of the virus.
5. If you are participating in a cleanup with persons not in your household, please stay 3 grabber lengths away (6 feet) from anyone who is not in your daily household group.
6. Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth while participating in cleanups.
7. After your litter pick up, wash your hands for at least 20 seconds with water and soap, or with hand sanitizer that is at least 60% alcohol.
8. It is the responsibility of the group leader to dispose of their trash bags at this time. Unfortunately, due to limited staffing, SCDOT is unable to provide this service until further notice.
9. Pick up and drop off supplies using the contactless method on the KMB porch at 1305 Augusta Road. Supplies will be cleaned and placed outside with group name on them prior to your clean up date at your request. Please do not touch items that do not have your group name on them. When you return the items, they will be left outside for 3 days and then sanitized by KMB staff.
10. All volunteers conduct litter cleanups at their own risk. The individual participants are aware of the potentially hazardous nature of the work which is to be performed and have agreed to follow SCDOT's safety guidelines and instructions and have agreed to NOT hold SCDOT, PalmettoPride, Keep the Midlands Beautiful or his/her sponsor(s) responsible for any injuries or illnesses they may suffer or damages they may cause or suffer, as result of participation in the Program.
