PROJECT STATUS UPDATE FOR U.S. EPA BROWNFIELDS-FUNDED CLEANUP
OLD WALDO COUNTY JAIL COMPLEX
45 CONGRESS STREET, BELFAST, MAINE**

Congress Street Hill Property, LLC (CSHP) will hold a public informational meeting and update on its United States Environmental Protection Agency (U.S. EPA) Brownfields-funded cleanup project for the Old Waldo County Jail Complex located at 45 Congress Street. CSHP has been awarded a cleanup grant in the amount of \$200,000 from the U.S. EPA Brownfields Program. The cleanup grant funds will be used, in part, to remediate hazardous building materials at the site. Bids have recently been received from abatement and cleanup contractors. Prior to the proposed cleanup construction work, CSHP is holding a public informational meeting to provide a project status and update.

The public meeting will be held at 6:00 pm on Thursday, May 11, 2017 at the Waldo County Emergency Management Building, located at 4 Public Safety Way, Belfast, Maine 04915. The information repository on this project, including prior environmental assessments and other environmental information is located at the Waldo County Clerk's Office, 39B Spring Street, Belfast, Maine 04915, and will be available for viewing during normal business hours (Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm).
