


**DEBRA PAUL vs. TOWN OF LIBERTY**

**PRESENT:** Waldo County Commissioners William D. Shorey, Chairman, Amy R. Fowler and Betty I. Johnson; Petitioner Debra Paul; Defendants Liberty Selectmen Steve Chapin, Pam Chase, and Jim Caldwell accompanied by Road Commissioner Tammy Reynolds. All parties met at 1:00 p.m. at the Liberty Town Office.
