JUSTINE E. MARKS (BEMCO) VERSUS TOWN OF BURNHAM:

On June 12, 2007, the three Waldo County Commissioners, John M. Hyk, Chairman; Amy R. Fowler, and Donald P. Berry, Sr. held a tax abatement hearing at the request of Plaintiff Justine E. Marks (BEMCO) regarding her property at 282 Troy Road listed on Map 8, Lot 30 of the Burnham tax map in Burnham Maine. Present with the Commissioners was Plaintiff Justine E. Marks and her associate Morris Coleman, along with Defendants Town of Burnham Assessors/Selectmen Luke Goodblood, Stuart C. Huff and George B. Robison. Recording the minutes was Waldo County Clerk Barbara L. Arseneau along with Deputy County Clerk Veronica Stover.

The Plaintiff requested abatement on said property in the amount of \$5,300.00 because she claimed the building could not be inhabited in its present condition and that a number of things had been stolen from the house including, but not limited to, various plumbing, electrical and aluminum pieces.

The Defendants explained that the building had already been assessed as being in "poor condition" at \$8,700.00.

After hearing the testimonies of the Plaintiffs and Defendants, the County Commissioners voted as follows:
