Upon the foregoing Decision and Order of Remand from the York County Superior Court, the Commissioners being satisfied that further inquiry into the matter is required and expedient, and that the Petitioner and Respondent Town of Brooks ought to be heard touching the matters set forth in the Court's Decision and Order of Remand and petition related thereto, it was

ORDERED:

That notice of the time, place and purpose of the Commissioners meeting aforesaid be given to all persons and corporations interested by mailing by certified mail an attested copy of the petition and this Order thereon, to the Chairman of the Board of Assessors, **Linda H. Lord, Town of Brooks ("Defendant")** and a like copy to **Duke Simoneau, ("Petitioner/Plaintiff")** that they may appear on that date and be heard if they think proper. The Assessors of said Town are further requested to present before said County Commissioners such town records that will enable said County Commissioners to arrive at a true and just decision.
