Jessie Royer is leading the Race to the Sky 300 mile race. She left White Tail Ranch checkpoint at 3:19 p.m. as predicted with 11 dogs on her way to the finish line. She spent the last 6 hours resting before heading to the finish line. She is expected to finish around 9:00 p.m. this evening.

All of the mushers have left Seeley Lake for White Tail Ranch: Gabe Dunham of Darby, Montana just arrived at White Tail Ranch checkpoint just before 5:00 p.m. She will have her six hour layover before she heads to the finish around 11 p.m. this evening which is about 52 miles.

Dunham is followed by Clayton Perry of Power, Montana, Cindy Gallea of Wykoff, Minnesota, Damon Ramaker of Fountain, Minnesota and last out of Seeley Lake was Kevin Mathis of Monoma Iowa. Once at the White Tail Ranch, each team is required to stay for a six hour mandatory layover before proceeding to the finish.
