Jessie Royer is leading the Race to the Sky 300 mile race. She arrived at Seeley Lake II at 11:18 p.m. Sunday night and left at 3:20 a.m. with 11 dogs on her way to White Tail Ranch. Once at the White Tail Ranch, she will have a 6 hour mandatory. She is about 20 miles from White Tail Ranch, which is 50 miles from Seeley Lake II at press time. We will update you when she arrives at White Tail Ranch checkpoint.

Still at Seeley Lake is Gabe Dunham of Darby, Montana, in at 4:12 a.m. with 11 dogs; Clayton Perry of Power, Montana, at 4:42 with 10 dogs, Cindy Gallea of Wykoff, Minnesota with 11 dogs and Damon Ramaker at 5:42 a.m. with 11 dogs.

Kevin Mathis of Monona, Iowa, was approximately 10 miles from Seeley Lake II at press time. He should be getting into Seeley Lake II around 8:30 a.m. Monday.

Patrick Roy of Paradise, Montana, Jesse Flory of Hesperus, Colorado and Jed Stephenson of Sand Point, Idaho withdrew from the race on Sunday afternoon.
