The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman, Steve Washkuhn.

Adjustment was made to the agenda to include approval of the Public Hearing minutes, and addition of discussion on Ambulance Service. Motion to approve the amended agenda was made by Cory Jackson, seconded by Steve Washkuhn. 2-0 motion carried.

Motion to approve minutes from June 14, 2017 meeting was made by Cory Jackson, seconded by Steve Washkuhn. 2-0 motion carried.

Motion to approve the Public Hearing minutes from June 14, 2017 was made by Steve Washkuhn, seconded by Cory Jackson. 2-0 motion carried.

Motion was made to approve the Treasurer report for the month of June 2017 was made by Steve Washkuhn, seconded by Cory Jackson. 2-0 motion carried.

Public comments: John Lesinak had questions for the board regarding the standing water issue in the township. Steve has received permission from landowner Waterfowl America, to go ahead and trap the beavers. Travis Gingras will be doing the trapping. Joe and Cory will be taking Travis out to the site tomorrow evening.

Jim Tolbert, Burnett County Emergency Government Director, introduced himself. He gave an overview of what services Emergency Government can assist townships with in the event of a disaster.

Road Maintenance: Steve received an estimate to repair the township dump truck from Monroe Trucking in the amount of \$9683.00. The repair of the truck is a necessity. Motion was made by Cory Jackson, seconded by Steve Washkuhn to proceed with Monroe Trucking to do the needed repairs. 2-0 motion carried.

Jim Peterson has expressed interest in the Road Maintenance position. With Joe Peterson absent tonight, we were able to get him on the telephone to see when he would be available for a special meeting to discuss the Road Maintenance position. It was agreed the Board will

meet on Friday, July 14, 2017 at 6 p.m. at the town hall to discuss. Wanda will get this meeting posted ASAP.

Meenon township will be done with the mower next week. Ike Peterson will begin the mowing as soon as we get the mower.

Stacy provided copies of the State Statutes which addresses dogs. Motion to adopt the State Statute, Chapter 174, in its entirety, was made by Steve Washkuhn seconded by Cory Jackson. 2-0 motion carried.

Steve gave an update on the status of the progress made by the Towns Association in regards to ambulance service. North Memorial will continue to provide services, with an increase in cost, but providing more services. Motion to accept option #7 was made by Steve Washkuhn, seconded by Cory Jackson. 2-0 motion carried.

The August meeting will be changed to Thursday, August 10, 2017, due to the fact that both Steve and Wanda are not available on August 9<sup>th</sup>.

Correspondence was looked over.

Motion to approve monthly bills as presented was made by Cory Jackson, seconded by Steve Washkuhn. 2-0 motion carried.
