Scholarship Criteria (All listed criteria must be met to qualify to apply for this scholarship.)

- Meet the application submission deadline of July 5, 2021
Be a first-generation student to pursue a post-secondary education
Meet at least once with the LEAP Coordinator (Shay Lastra) for a scheduled interview
Hold an immigration status as DACA or as undocumented
Be enrolled as a full-time student for the semester in which the scholarship is awarded
Demonstrate financial need
Have a high school GPA of a minimum of 3.0 or a 450 GED Score
Demonstrate a history of community involvement or as holding a part-time or full-time job
