

Fr. Kelly's Trip to Guatemala

On June 8th I traveled to Guatemala City to participate in an awareness trip sponsored by Unbound out of Kansas City. Once in Guatemala, I met up with 25 other travelers from 10 states, all of whom had sponsored children in Guatemala. Each of us had the chance to meet with our sponsored child. My sponsored child is Zoila, whom I have sponsored for over 10 years. She is now 18, and I met her and her mother and her grandmother. Each day we would load the bus and travel to another village to meet a group of sponsored children who would put on a program for us as a way of offering thanks for the help they were receiving for their education and other basic necessities of life. While there, I met Fr. John Goggin, who is the pastor of San Lucas, the parish we support here at St. Mary's, and he wanted me to be sure to thank the people in Spirit Lake for the monthly donations, which have recently been used to build houses. Overall, it was a very rewarding trip and shows just how making small contributions can make such a difference in the lives of the poor.
