

ORDINANCE NO. 2-2019

**DUNKARD TOWNSHIP
GREENE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DUNKARD TOWNSHIP, GREENE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF DUNKARD TOWNSHIP TO ENTER INTO AN INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT WITH CUMBERLAND TOWNSHIP FOR THE PURPOSES OF POLICE PROTECTION UNDER THE AUTHORITY OF THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL COOPERATION ACT.

WHEREAS, Dunkard Township and Cumberland Township have negotiated an agreement for Cumberland Township to provide services to Dunkard Township pursuant to the terms and conditions of the attached agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Dunkard Township believe it to be in the best interest of its residents to enter into the attached agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Dunkard Township under and by virtue of, and pursuant to the authority granted by the Second-Class Township Code, as amended, does hereby **ENACT** and **ORDAIN** as follows:

SECTION 1. TITLE

This Ordinance shall be known as the “Dunkard Township Intergovernmental Agreement with Cumberland Township Ordinance of 2019.

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT AND APPLICABILITY

The background of this Ordinance and the legislative intention of the Board of Supervisors of Dunkard Township in enacting the aforesaid are as follows:

A. Dunkard Township and Cumberland Township are Townships organized and existing under the Second Class Township Code.

B. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has provided for intergovernmental cooperation in the performance of governmental functions and powers by the Acts of December 19, 1996, P.L. 1158, No. 177 § 2301, as amended.

C. The Intergovernmental Cooperation Act authorizes two (2) or more local governments in the Commonwealth to jointly cooperate in the exercise or in the performance of their respective governmental functions, powers or responsibilities, so long as both municipalities adopt an ordinance so providing.

D. The Board of Supervisors have determined that it is in the best interest of Dunkard Township to enter into an Agreement with Cumberland Township for the provision of Police Services to Dunkard Township and as set forth in the attached agreement.

SECTION 3. INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT

The covenants, terms and conditions of the Intermunicipal Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

SECTION 4. DURATION OF AGREEMENT

The duration of the aforesaid agreement is set forth therein unless and until terminated by either party.

SECTION 5. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES OF THE AGREEMENT

The purpose of the aforesaid agreement is to provide Police protection by Cumberland Township to the residents of Dunkard Township as set forth therein.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

In the event that any provision, section, sentence or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such invalidity shall not effect or impair any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance,

as the provision are severable and would have been enacted had not such invalid provision been included herein.

SECTION 7. REPEALER

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its approval as provided by law.


