

**DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY
DUNKARD TOWNSHIP
GREENE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

WHEREAS, on or about March 23, 2020 a Coronavirus pandemic has caused or threatens to cause injury, damage and suffering to the persons and property of Dunkard Township; and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus pandemic has endangered the health, safety and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in Dunkard Township and threatens to create problems greater in scope than Dunkard Township may be able to resolve; and

WHEREAS, emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety and welfare of affected residents in Dunkard Township.


NOW, THEREFORE, by the Board of Supervisors of Dunkard Township, Greene County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA C.S., Section 7501), as amended, do hereby proclaim the existence of a disaster emergency in Dunkard Township.

FURTHER, we direct the Dunkard Township Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this emergency.

STILL FURTHER, we authorize officials of Dunkard Township to act as necessary to meet the current demands of this emergency, namely: by the employment of temporary workers, by the rental of equipment, by the purchase of supplies and materials and by entering into such contracts and agreements for the performance of public work as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, mandatory constitutional requirements excepted.


This Declaration shall take effect until December 31, 2020. This runs concurrent with the Commonwealth Declaration.


