Item #1 Is it possible to add the EQT Heavy Hauling Agreement approval for the Chevron roadways that are currently bonded to the agenda. This agreement would transfer the current Agreement from Chevron to EQT. Chris thought this to be best. The agreement would be the exact wording as the Chevron Agreement before. (not any new provisions). The only different item would remove the extended warranty for the retaining wall on Smith Creek Road. This may have already been approved previously.

Item #2 Could you also add a note about applying for Stimulus funding through the County for the sewage project. We have already requested additional funding with Crystal.

Item #3 Dunkard-Bobtown Municipal Authority - Letter request for American Recovery Funding. I am drafting the letter on behalf of the Authority now.

Item #4 Status report on the Colvin Building Demolition. Notice to Proceed has been issued, Greene County has been notified for Employee income surveys, Asbestos has been removed, Demolition has begun and the building is on the ground, contractor saturated the site with water to help keep dust under control while demolition was occurring, Steel scrap is currently being hauled away, EADS has a part time inspector reviewing the progress, no additional issues have been identified at this point and No payment requests have been received at this time.
