Very Important Reminders:

- Register for your CCU Dual Credit course here: secure.ccu.edu/dualcredits
- Pay attention to registration deadlines:
 - November 15th for Fall courses
 - April 15th for Yearlong/ Spring courses
- Earn a C or above to ensure your credit is able to transfer
- Sign up for WebAdvisor to access unofficial transcripts, check if grades are posted, and access CCU's online library resources

 - 2) Log in to WebAdvisor using CCU ID# and password (from above): <https://webadvisor.ccu.edu>
- Order transcripts once you have graduated from high school: ccu.edu/transcript
 - First, check on WebAdvisor that all grades have been posted
 - OR, indicate that you wish to have your transcript held until current semester grades are posted
