**Mayor Joseph Bucco led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.**

**MAYOR JOSEPH BUCCO – ANNOUNCEMENTS:**

**Mayor Joseph Bucco stated the Public Hearing entitled "Continuation of Introductory Local Law Regulating Certain Solar Energy Systems and Equipment within the Village of Washingtonville" has been rescheduled until Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at 7:00 P.M.**

**Mayor Bucco indicated discussion will take place at the July 17 Village Board Regular Meeting regarding the updated proposed changes to the Frontier Communications Franchise Agreement submitted by Village Attorney William Frank.**

**Audience member and Town of Blooming Grove Highway Department Superintendent Wayne Kirkpatrick came before the Village Board on behalf of Town Supervisor Robert Jeroloman to discuss the idea of installation of a wash pad for Village and Town vehicles at the Town Central Garage located in the Village. project would have minimal impact to the Village, and the Town is requesting consideration be given towards the water – sewer usage billing. The Village Board expressed concerns regarding run-off location from the wash pad.

Audience member Sean Hegarty, 4 Belvoir Drive stated Ahern Boulevard needs to be cleaned and swept because there is silt and debris from Rieger Homes trucks that is running into Village storm drains when it rains. Mr. Hegarty suggested silt screens should be installed on the storm drains in this area as they are on other drains throughout the Village of Washingtonville.
