RESOLUTION – SCHEDULE PUBLIC HEARING – “TAX LEVY LIMIT OVERRIDE – 2020 – 2021 FISCAL YEAR”:

Deputy Mayor Lang made a motion, seconded by Trustee Calore and adopted to schedule a Public Hearing regarding adoption of Introductory Local Law entitled “Tax Levy Limit Override – 2020 – 2021 Fiscal Year” to be held on Tuesday, January 21 at 7:00 P.M.”; said Resolution passed by a unanimous Vote of the Village Board. 5 Ayes, 0 Nays, 0 Abstentions.

The Mayor reviewed General Fund Budget items which included Village Hall; Municipal Services; Shared Services; Special Items; Law Enforcement; Public Safety; Department of Public Works (D.P.W.); Streets and Parks; Youth Recreation Programs; Culture; Zoning and Planning; Sanitation; Community and Environment; Employee Benefits and Debt Service; Code Enforcement; Building Inspector; Fire Inspector and Village Historian.

The Village Water and Sewer Budget items were also discussed including Water and Sewer Professional Services and Debt Services.
