### This Week's Legislative Action

**HB356: relative to the city of Manchester employees' contributory retirement system.**

- Original Policy Committee: House ED&A
- Sponsors: [Patrick Long](#)
- Coalition Position: MONITOR
- **Action:** Governor Sununu signed this bill into law this week. This bill is administrative only and does not impact the benefits for members of the Manchester City Retirement System.

**HB130: relative to administration by the retirement system of certain health care premium deductions.**

- Original Policy Committee: House ED&A

- Coalition Position: MONITOR
- **Action:** The Senate ED&A Committee voted to ITL, HB130. This bill is administrative only and deals with a transfer of money between the NH Retirement System and NH Department of Administrative Services regarding the state retiree medical subsidy benefit. The issue at hand does NOT impact member benefits. An amendment had been included in the state budget, but concerns have been raised with the language of this amendment. The Senate has requested NHRS and DAS work together to come up with a solution to present to the legislature.
